

#### **OUR SUMMER SEMINARIANS**

St. Catherine's is once again be hosting two of our diocesan seminarians for eight weeks this summer. A couple of summer again Tim Kraemer and Brendon Schneibel were here; next month now Deacon Tim Kraemer will be ordained a priest and Brendon will be ordained a deacon. Last summer Taylor Ternes and Garrett Aberle were at St Catherine's for the summer - both will be ordained deacons this also along with Brendon.

This summer's twosome is a bit different - both of them are in minor seminary (college level) at St Gregory the Great Seminary in Seward, Nebraska. (This is the seminary the Bishop Folda was the rector of before he was named the Bishop of Fargo and moved here.) They will both be in their last year of minor seminary this coming formation year, and will then move on next year to major seminary for the last years of formation before ordination.
