




CLEAN-UP

There's a lot of hurting souls out there these days - and a lot of clean-up that's just begun. Our parish itself incurred very little damage, and so I am thankful for that. But I am also aware that many of our parishioners - and frankly, most everyone - has incurred some damage and some with substantial damage. Know of my prayers - it's about all I can offer at this point. But it's the best I can offer. The Lord God exhibits His power in many ways in creation - even in the power we see in storms. But the Lord God also exhibits His power in us, also a part of His creation - and a much dearer part to Him than all of the rest of this creation we are surrounded in and live in.

The Lord God is Himself intimately familiar with the concept of "clean-up." We see hundreds of trees down, damage to buildings, boats, and property - and that is heartbreaking. Can you imagine His vision of the literally *billions* of souls so far created by Him as His children, and the damage, brokenness, and even damnation they experience due to sin? Ever since the Original Sin in the Garden of Eden, our Lord God has been "cleaning up" the damage we have brought into this world.

He knows the heartbreak of damage and loss. But He also knows the glory of rising up from that, the effort, sweat and toil it takes - as well as the suffering that comes in the process of that - and the grace and happiness that comes from perseverance and long-suffering in rebuilding ourselves and what is around us once again. We have not always been with Him, but He has always been with us, through thick and thin. May our faith be strengthened and may our wills be strengthened, along with our bodies, to do what needs to be done in "cleaning up" the damage around us - and within us.




