The Convent Project will take place in three phases;

PHASE I - Abatement and Demolition **PHASE II** - Electrical

PHASE III - Landscaping and renovations to add space to the TK and Kindergarten play area and complete the new parish meeting space.

****ABATEMENT** will begin **June 16, 2022** and **DEMOLITION** is scheduled to begin **July 25, 2022**. **Phase II** (Electrical) will need to begin soon after the first phase is complete and will require us to raise the funds needed for the electrical portion of the project prior to the work beginning. The estimated cost to complete all three phases of the project is approximately \$212,796 (not all proposals for the project have been finalized due to changing supply costs and other factors)

World Day of Prayer for Vocations ~ May 8, 2022

The purpose of World Day of Prayer for Vocations is to publicly fulfill the Lord's instruction to, "Pray the Lord of the harvest to send laborers into his harvest" (Mt 9:38; Lk 10:2). As a climax to a prayer that is continually offered throughout the Church, it affirms the primacy of faith and grace in all that concerns vocations to the priesthood and to the consecrated life. While appreciating all vocations, the Church concentrates its attention this day on vocations to the ordained ministries (priesthood and diaconate), consecrated life in all its forms (male and female religious life, societies of apostolic life, consecrated virginity), secular institutes in their diversity of services and membership, and to the missionary life.

2022 marks the 59th Anniversary of the World Day of Prayer for Vocations.

The children return to the Church when the Liturgy of the Eucharist begins.

Archdiocesan guidelines recommended age for admission is four years of age for Transitional Kindergarten and five years of age for Kindergarten students, on or before September 1, but required by December 1. An assessment of all incoming Kindergarten students interested in attending St. Cyprian Parish School for the 2022 - 2023 academic school year is required in order to best meet the individual needs of each student. 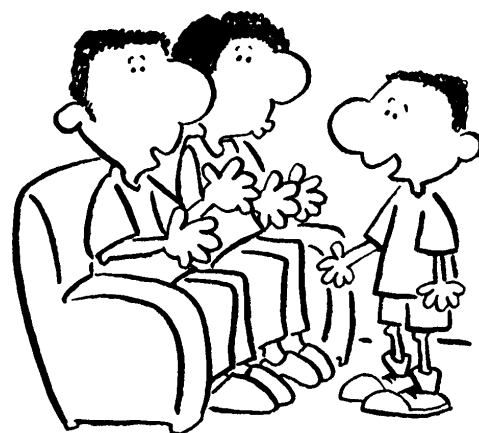

DID YOU KNOW? - *Know who to call in California*

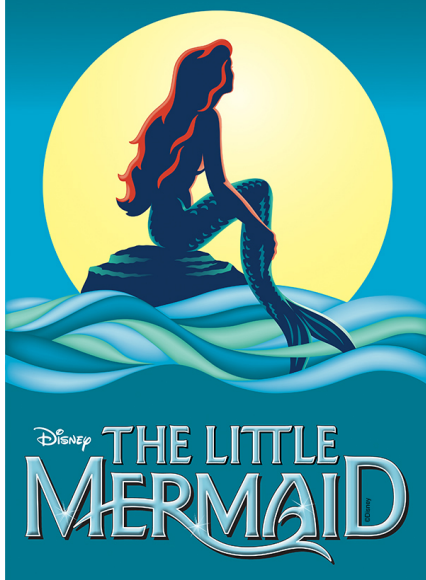

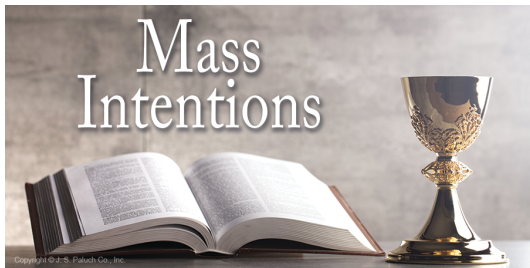
