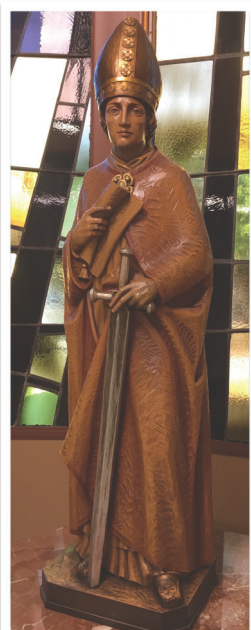

CONVENT PROJECT

Our special 2nd collection at Masses for the Convent Project has concluded. We will continue to accept all convent project donations throughout the months of November and December that are placed in the green envelopes. All Building Fund donations for the months of November and December will also be used for the convent project.

The Convent Project will take place in three phases;

PHASE I - Abatement and Demolition **PHASE II** - Electrical

PHASE III - Landscaping and renovations

****ABATEMENT** is completed and **DEMOLITION** will conclude as soon as all the permits from the city of Long Beach have been received. Once DEMO is complete we will begin to move into **Phase II** (Electrical). We have calculated the estimated cost to complete all three phases of the project at approximately \$225,000 (not all proposals for the project have been finalized due to changing supply costs and other factors)

Sunday, November 27th during the 10:30AM Mass

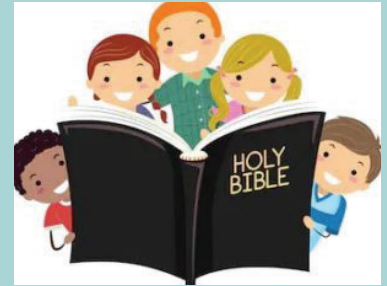
All students in grades 1st - 6th are welcome!

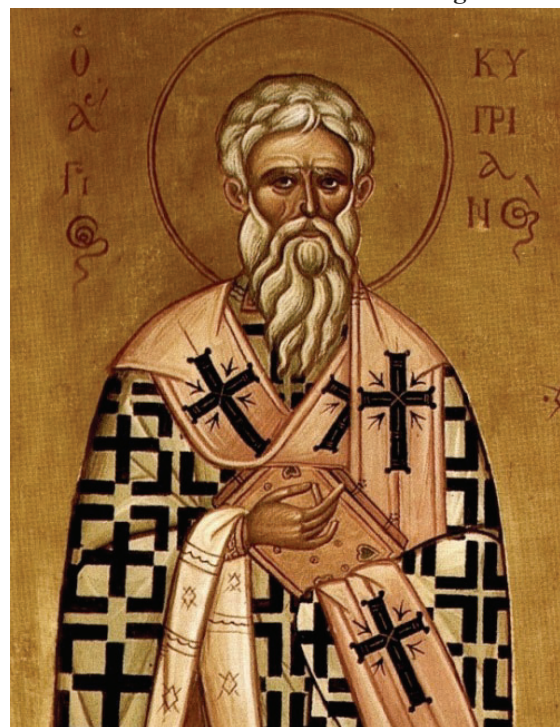

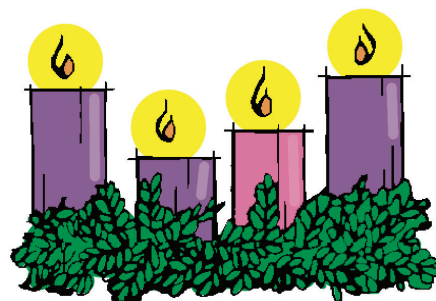

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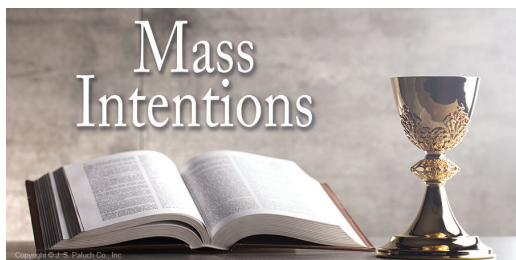
