Event Recap

Budget Overview

- Joy provided an update on the current budget. Updates since the last meeting was ~\$800 in income due to money from corporate matching from boosterthon coming in
- Expenses since the last meeting included payment for CSW entertainment, Valentine's day treats, teacher requests approved at last meeting and book fair egift cards
- Changes were made to some of the line items of the budget. We added the 1st day of spring gifts (small flower starter kit with a "Happy Spring" note. These will be distributed on March 21st. More money was allocated

to the spring dance to purchase new decorations. SPA will now be paying for the DJ for the middle school dance. For the teacher appreciation luncheon the gift cards for the staff will increase from \$25 to \$50.

- SPA will be purchasing a new gym flag. Thank you to Marianne for doing the leg work on this. The price is pending but will include installation
- At this time after paying for the remaining SPA events, SPA programming and other line items (see budget for details) we estimate there to be \$26,591 in remaining funds for new initiatives.
