



Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK Fr. Dominic Y. Afrifa

Our Hope in the Life to come.

Wisdom 3:1–9 Psalms 23:1–3A, 3B–4, 5, 6 Romans 5:5–11 or Romans 6:3–9 John 6:37–40

Yesterday we celebrated all Saints. We concentrated on all those who despite the difficulties we face presently persisted and ended up in the kingdom of God as victors. Today we celebrate ALL SOULS. This is both the victorious and the suffering. We need to seek the intercession of the victorious family members, parishioners and friends and we have to pray for those who are suffering. This is the essence of our commemoration. This is also to remind us that one day we will be in the state they have now. So, we need to prepare ourselves.

When St. Paul talked about the resurrection of the dead with the philosophers at Athens, many laughed and mocked him (Acts 17:32). The Gospel, he would later write, is "foolishness" to the wise of this world (1 Corinthians 1:18). Yet this week's First Reading tells us that it is foolish to think that the souls of the just are dead. They are rather with God. Their place has changed. They are not physically present but they are not absent.

Theirs is a "hope full of immortality." By His Resurrection, Jesus frees the human race from the fear of death—from the terrible fear of the unknown, of our own disintegration—that holds us in a kind of slavery (Hebrews 2:14–15). Because He has walked the dark valley of death before us, because He has promised to walk alongside us, we can take "courage" and "fear no evil," in the words of this week's Psalm.

This is God's will for us, the reason Jesus came into the world, according to today's Gospel: that we will recognize Jesus as the Son of God and by believing in Him be raised to eternal life. If we believe in Him, we will follow Him, as the Psalmist says: He will refresh our souls in the waters of Baptism, anoint our heads with the oil of Confirmation, and set before us the table of the Eucharist.

There our cups will be filled to overflowing. And by these mysteries of His kindness and goodness, we will "dwell in the house of the Lord" in this life and in the life to come. The First Reading seems to allude to the doctrine of Purgatory, to the souls of the just being chastised, purified as gold in a furnace and made worthy of God (1 Corinthians 3:11–12).

This reading also tells us of the glory of the saints, who will share in the rule of Christ, judging and ruling over the nations (Luke 22:30). Through the "newness of life" we have in the sacraments, this week's Epistle adds, we "grow into union" with Jesus, confident that we will be together with Him when He comes again at the end of time.

Jesus was not seen to be doing His own will but the will of the Father. And the will of the father is that everyone who see the Son and believes in Him may have eternal life. Have you seen the son? Do you believe in Him? If answers to these are YES, then we are assured of life after death.

May the one who won His war against death once and for all increase our faith in Him so that we will not be lost but see his face on the life eternal. Amen.




