Designated Parking

We would like to remind everyone to not park or stop their cars, even for a short moment, in the large main circle. This blocks access to emergency vehicles and blocks the flow of traffic. This became evident last weekend when emergency vehicles were needed during the 8:30 Mass. Children for Faith Formation should be dropped off using the car-line that forms in the small south parking lot. The children should be picked-up inside Kaplan Parish Hall. Parents should park in designated parking spots in order to pick-up their children after Children's Faith Formation. Those with limited mobility who need closer access to the building for Mass should be dropped-off on the north side of the building around the small circle with the flag pole. Please also use the smaller circle for anyone needing to be picked-up after Mass. This allows the main circle to remain clear and accessible when emergency vehicles are needed. We Are Prophets of a Future Not Our Own- A Stewardship Message

In the past couple of weeks, we have been sharing excerpts from "The Romero Prayer" in preparation for our Annual Parish Appeal. The late Bishop Ken Untener of Saginaw drafted this for a homily by Cardinal John Dearden in November 1979 for a celebration of departed priests. As a reflection on the anniversary of the martyrdom of Bishop Romero, Bishop Untener included in a reflection book a passage titled "The mystery of the Romero Prayer." The mystery is that the words of the prayer are commonly attributed to Oscar Romero, but they were never spoken by him. Here is another excerpt: No statement says all that could be said. No prayer fully expresses our faith. No confession brings perfection.
