Book of the Dead The Book of the Dead will be displayed throughout the month next to the Baptismal Font. It is through Baptism that all Christians die with Christ and are raised in Him. All are invited to inscribe the names of those who have died so that our parish may remember them. A poster, displayed as a Wall of Memory, reminds us of those parishioners who have gone to meet the Lord in the past year.

Visiting a Cemetery During this month we are all encouraged to visit the graves of loved ones. We decorate these graves because we believe that in Baptism they have died with Christ and thus Christ will raise them up. We may place an evergreen wreath as a reminder of the ancient crown of victory over death and of the eternal life promised to us in Baptism. We may light a candle at a grave, a reflection of the light of Christ given in Baptism. This also harkens to the wise bridesmaids who kept their lamps burning while waiting for the bridegroom to arrive so that the wedding feast could begin.
