Would You Like to Become a Saint? What is "the surest, easiest, shortest, and most perfect means to becoming a saint"? The answer is through Mary to Jesus because Mary always points to her Son! The quote is taken from the spiritual classic, True Devotion to Mary written by St. Louis Marie de Montfort. Many Legion of Mary members and fellow parishioners are renewing their 33-day total consecration to Jesus through Mary which begins on February 20, 2023. The 33-day preparation concludes with the recitation of the promise on the Feast of the Annunciation which will be celebrated this year on Saturday, March 25, at the end of the 9 am Mass at Saint Bede Church. What does consecration mean? When Mary became our spiritual mother at the foot of the Cross, her mission was to help each of us grow in holiness. The Total Consecration to Jesus through Mary is a 33-day period of prayers and meditation. We freely give full permission for Mary, our spiritual mother, to work in us and her Spouse, the Holy Spirit. It is a devotion that continues after the recitation to embrace Mary's guidance into one's entire life as a unique path to deeper spirituality and holiness.
