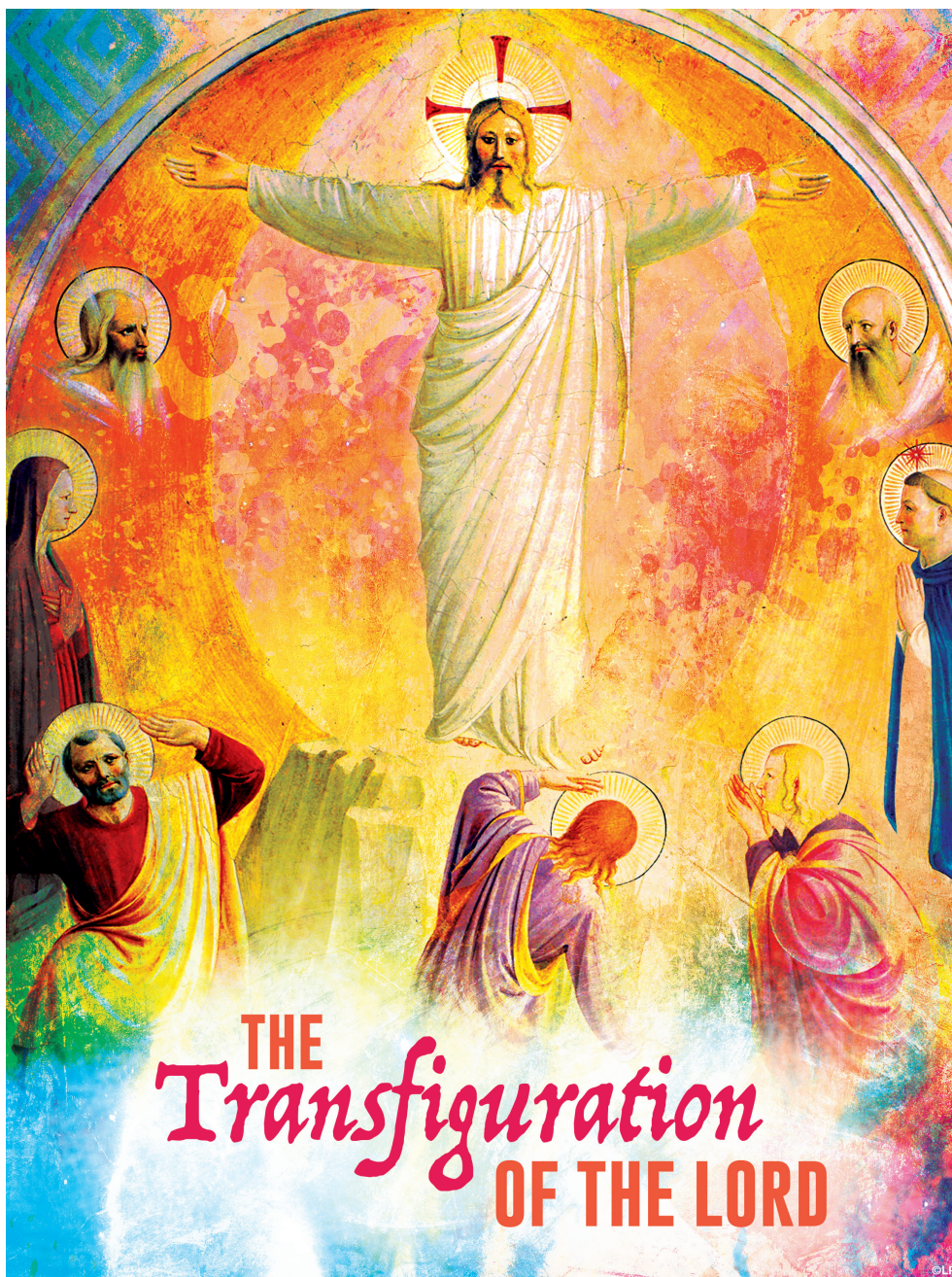

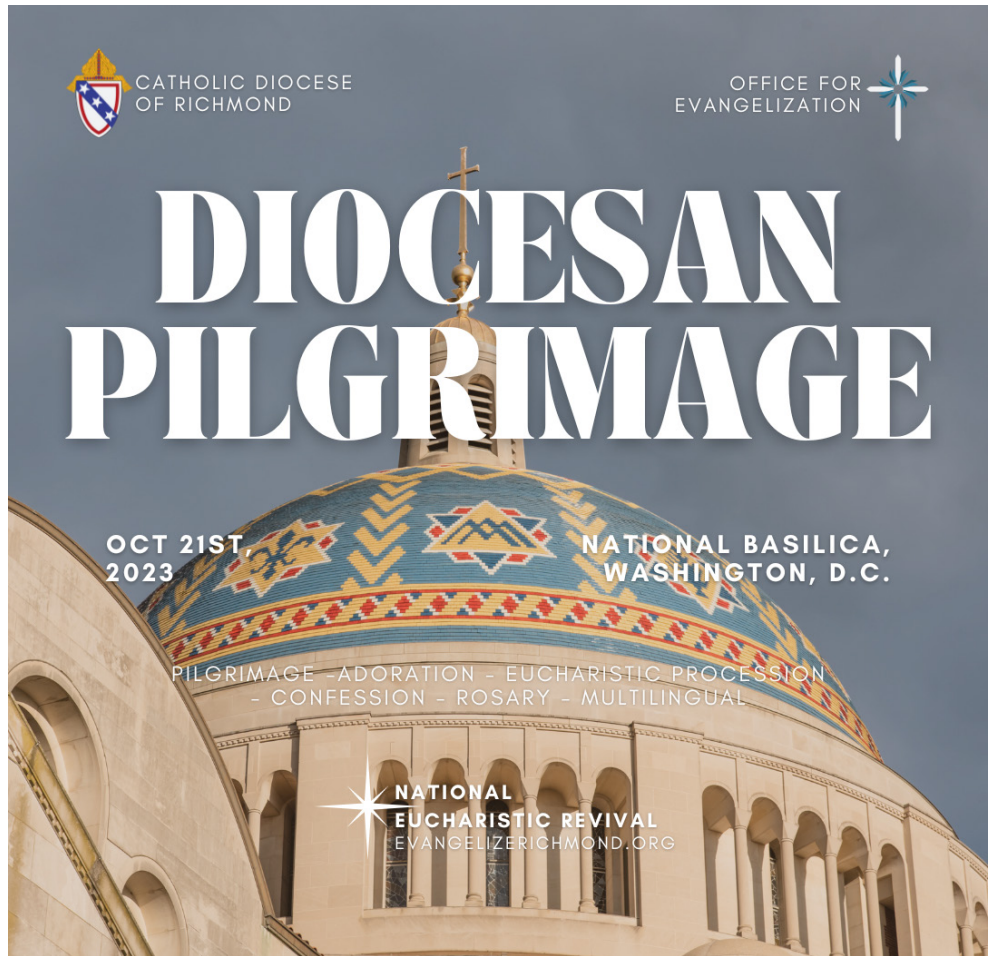

WHY DO PARISHES OFFER SPECIAL MASSES LIKE THANKSGIVING AND MEMORIAL DAY, EVEN THOUGH THEY'RE NOT HOLY DAYS OF OBLIGATION? AM I OBLIGATED TO ATTEND?

Out of respect for the various civil celebrations that take place during the year, many dioceses and parishes will host special Masses. However, while it is always worthwhile to come together to worship as a community, Catholics are not obligated to attend these celebrations. As the Catechism of the Catholic Church notes, the only times that we are obligated to participate in celebrations of the Eucharist are on Sundays and holy days of obligation:

The first precept is "You shall attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation and rest from servile labor". This requires the faithful to sanctify the day commemorating the Resurrection of the Lord as well as the principal liturgical feasts that honor the mysteries of the Lord, the Blessed Virgin Mary, and the saints. By participating in the Eucharistic celebration, in which the Christian community is gathered, and by resting from those works and activities which could impede such a sanctification of these days, we are keeping the Sabbath holy.

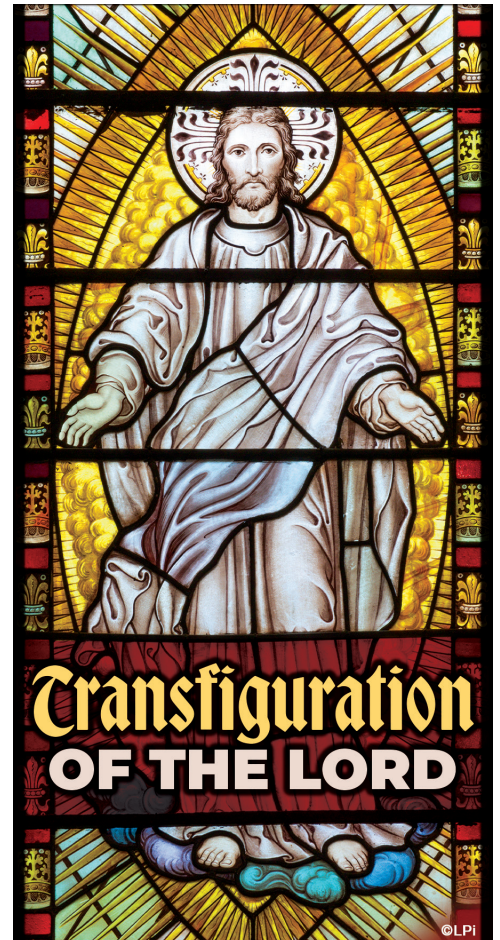

GOSPEL MEDITATION**THE EIGHTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

What is Christianity finally about? These days if you ask almost anyone who doesn't know the Bible you'll probably hear an answer like this: "Being a good person" or "following the golden rule." No offense to the golden rule, but our faith is simply much deeper than that. This week's feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord is a luminous example of this. Jesus becomes radiantly and overwhelmingly beautiful. The glory of God literally shines forth from his body and even his clothes. Here we see that Christianity is not mainly a moral system, but a relationship with God in Christ, one that finally makes human beings gloriously beautiful.

Now we can see our good and bad deeds in a new and de-centered way. Our morality isn't about a heaven or hell scorecard. It's about lives open (or closed) to transfiguration, lives capable of revealing the glory of God in Christ to the world. Spouses, children, friends, co-workers, priests, consecrated women and men, and so on — we are all called to let the beauty of Jesus make our lives beautiful, little by little. STEWARDSHIP UPDATE

SERVICE, THE FOURTH PILLAR OF STEWARDSHIP

In their book, *Stewardship Success*, Eric and Lisa McArdle describe the elements that help us make stewardship a way of life. We have looked at Hospitality, Prayer and Formation, and now we look at the final pillar, Service.

All of the things we learn through the other pillars are brought to fullness through our service to others. We have so many opportunities in our parish and community. If we are followers of Christ then we must also serve.

How are you serving others? It can be hard with our busy lives. Serving isn't just writing the check or showing up on Sundays to "check the box" for attending Mass. SACRED ART UPDATE

We continue to make progress with completing the Communion of Saints Around the Altar project. We have 2 panels of mosaics onsite and expect two more to arrive in the next month along with 6 support panels. The last two panels for this order will not be complete until sometime in late fall or early winter. Our plan is to install 6 panels (#'s 28-33) on the left side as soon as the last two are delivered. The artist for the project, Angel Ramiro Sanchez, will be in Williamsburg September 1st and 2nd so stay tuned for an opportunity to hear him present on the final phase of the project which will include the Mexican Martyrs from the early 1900's. As a reminder, we try to display the original painting on or about the Saint's feast day in our library in the Commons.
