

No matter who we are, our inner lives affect the way we interact with the world. In the United States, we have freedom of religion. That means there is no official state-sanctioned religion. This does not mean that our faith is a private affair with no impact on public life! We have the ability to freely exercise our religious beliefs in accord with our conscience. Not only do we have the option to do so, but we also have the responsibility.

We're called to imitate Christ in every area of our life, not compartmentalize our faith. This means acting with respect and honoring the common humanity we all encounter. It means recognizing the person behind the politics. It also means standing up for the truth of human life and dignity and advocating for just policies that serve the common good. The Vatican has produced a "Compendium of the Social Doctrine of the Church." It contains more detailed exposition of how our Catholic faith relates to various aspects of public life.




A man at my parish was struggling to overcome a habitual sin. He said to me, "Father, I know the chance that I will commit sin again is really high. Why should I keep confessing my sins? Isn't that dishonest?" Anyone who has felt the tyrannical power of sin — and who hasn't? — has pondered this kind of question.

I responded to him, "What was the probability Peter would walk on the stormy water?" After some silence, he said, "Zero. But when Jesus called, he did it." I could tell my penitent friend was re-framing the question from his own weakness to the greatness of the Lord's love for him. The question for us should not be one of human probabilities about our sin, but rather whether or not we will trust the Lord's grace in our lives.

This week the Lord is calling you and me to do the impossible: overcome sin with love. The only way to do that is to trust he is calling, and then to walk with the eyes of faith locked on him. And if we sink, he will raise us up again and again. Of that, we can be 100% sure.

19° Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Este pasaje de Mateo nos lleva a reflexionar sobre la importancia de la fe y de cómo la profesamos a lo largo de nuestra vida. Desarrollar la fe es un proceso que da comienzo el día de nuestro bautismo. En ese momento fue plantada la semilla de la fe. Ya de adultos, escuchar la Palabra de Dios nos ayuda a enfrentar las tormentas cotidianas. A veces se tambalea nuestra fe. Pareciera que nada vale la pena y es cuando acudimos al Señor, como Pedro en el Evangelio, y viene el grito de: ¡Sálvame, Señor! de la incertidumbre, del miedo y de la falta de paz en nuestras ciudades, en las familias y en nuestros corazones. A pesar de nuestra poca fe, queremos ser fieles a Jesús y sus enseñanzas. Solo él puede salvarnos.

Aunque vacile a causa de mis debilidades, tómame de tu mano y llévame hacia ti. Porque tú no eres un fantasma, eres el Hijo de Dios. Eres quien me tranquiliza, me da paz y serenidad para discernir, con la ayuda del Espíritu Santo, lo mejor para salvarme, para salvarnos en familia, en comunidad. Para eso tenemos su Palabra y la Iglesia que nos ayuda y guía en todos los tiempos. "Cerca está su salvación de los que le temen y habitará su Gloria en nuestra tierra. La Gracia y la Verdad se han encontrado, la Justicia y la Paz se han abrazado; de la tierra está brotando la verdad, y del cielo se asoma la justicia" (Salmo 85:10-12). We continue to make progress with completing the Communion of Saints Around the Altar project. We have 2 panels of mosaics onsite and expect two more to arrive in the next month along with 6 support panels. The last two panels for this order will not be complete until sometime in late fall or early winter. Our plan is to install 6 panels (#'s 28-33) on the left side as soon as the last two are delivered. The artist for the project, Angel Ramiro Sanchez, will be in Williamsburg September 1st and 2nd so stay tuned for an opportunity to hear him present on the final phase of the project which will include the Mexican Martyrs from the early 1900's. As a reminder, we try to display the original painting on or about the Saint's feast day in our library in the Commons.
