FIFTH SUNDAY OF EASTER



My friend and fellow pastor, Father Paul, noticed unsightly, overgrown trees near his parish church. He asked the maintenance crew to cut back the growth, which they happily did, telling him the trees would be much healthier and even fuller after a good pruning. A few days

later, Father Paul received a letter from an irate man in the neighborhood who wrote, “Jesus would never prune trees like that. He loves trees, unlike you.”

I suspect that the neighbor was not familiar with this week’s Gospel in which Jesus says of his Father, “He removes every branch in me that bears no fruit. Every branch that bears fruit he prunes to make it bear more fruit” (John 15:2) I don’t mean to pick too much on that fellow. He was perhaps ignorant of arboriculture. But I’d wager his main confusion was the pruning and removing quality of God’s love. That confusion afflicts us all to some degree, doesn’t it? It is just so darn easy to react negatively when God cuts something out of our lives and assume it’s not his work at all. In the moment, all we see is the loss, and not the loving desire for future flourishing.

The cross is the great pruning of Christ’s body. Jesus’ rising is the brand-new growth. It is God’s promise to us that all the painful pruning in life is leading us somewhere beautiful. What has been cut back or out in your life? A friend, an opportunity, a sense of certainty, a job, health, a relationship? This week, offer those dry branches to the one who lovingly prunes us in order to make our lives burst with verdant growth.

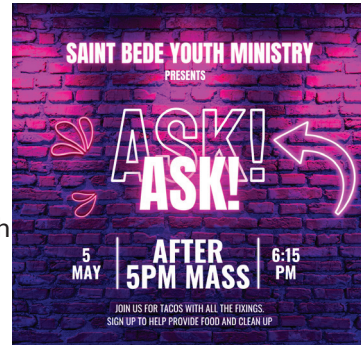

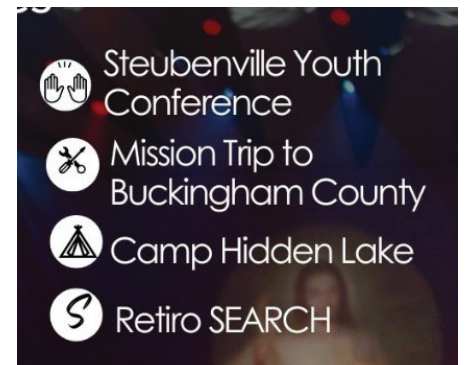

STEWARDSHIP UPDATE

One key trait of a Stewardship parish is Hospitality. Do we not only welcome folks but do we truly provide care and fellowship as well?

Hospitality is much more than a simple welcome. Hospitality is found throughout sacred scripture and was featured in Christ's teaching and actions. In Matthew 25: 35-40, Christ gave us a practical guide: "For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, a stranger and you welcomed me...". Hospitality is service to others, sharing what we have with the Love and Joy of Christ. Think about the words we speak at Communion: "Lord, I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof...". We are invited into Christ's house to share the heavenly banquet.

Do we invite others or accept their invitations in that same way? Be open to the opportunity to share hospitality regularly both at church and in the community. It could be staying to visit after Mass, getting together for coffee, or through service to others. The harvest of hospitality opportunities is abundant, are you open to making or accepting the invitation?

On May 19 after the 11 am Mass, we will explore welcoming and hospitality here at Saint Bede and look for ways we can become more like Christ. PROTECT YOUR FAMILY ... NO MATTER WHAT AGE YOU ARE.

Talk with your family about important matters. If something happens to you or your spouse, who will care for your children? Do you have a will? Advance Medical Directive? Powers of Attorney?
