

GOSPEL MEDITATION

THE MOST HOLY TRIINITY



Once I was at a meeting with representatives of various religions. On a coffee break, a man from another religion mused to me: "You know, with all our differences, all religions are really about being good people." I lowered my

cappuccino and said as warmly as I could, "That's not what mine's about." His quizzical look begged for clarification. "Mine is about plunging into the life of God," I said.

Just before Jesus ascends into heaven, he commands the eleven apostles, "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you; and behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age." (Matthew 28:19-20). The word "baptize" means "to immerse in, to plunge into." It presupposes the use of water. But what does it mean to be immersed in God's name? In the Bible, God's name is identical to God Himself. So, to be baptized into water, using Jesus' formula, is to be plunged into the life of God. Said another way, it is to die with Jesus and rise with him as a member of his body.

The Trinity isn't a doctrine simply to accept and ponder. It's more like an ocean: a mystery into which we are baptized ... inserted, immersed, dunked, plunged. Baptism gives us power to live our lives as beloved children of God, patterned after Jesus himself, who is always with us, until the end of the ages. Hardly the same as being good people. Stranger, but much better.

CORPUS CHRISTI

SUNDAY, JUNE 2 - INCENSE WILL BE USED AT THE 11AM AND 5PM MASSES

We celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. In the Eucharistic feast, the gifts of bread and wine really and truly become the Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Christ.

Our parish will celebrate this public witness with a Eucharistic Procession at the conclusion of the 11 am bilingual Mass this Sunday. We will process with the Blessed Sacrament outside following the driveway around the grass circle in front of the church. There will be four altars set up around the circle where the procession will pause for singing and benediction.

All are encouraged to participate as we outwardly manifest our belief in this heavenly food on this great solemnity. Recent First Communicants are invited to participate in the procession dressed in their suit/dress that was worn for First Communion.

For safety reasons, the exit from the small South parking lot will not be accessible following the 11am Mass and the two exits into the circle from the large North parking lot will also be blocked off. Egress from the large lot will be at the West end.

If you are unable to stay for the procession, we ask that you leave reverently and quietly.

Sharing the Gospel


