





#### **GOSPEL MEDITATION**

#### SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT



In the year 1995, in the seventeenth year of my life, when Fife Symington was governor of Arizona, Bill Clinton was president of the United States, Chuck Keiffer was pastor of St. Theresa parish in Phoenix, Arizona, and Ron and Mary were my parents, the word of God came to my youth minister Eric and through him I started to see the salvation of God. Soon, Christ came into my life never to leave. I'm thankful beyond words.

Why am I being so specific, you ask? Because in the Gospel this week we hear the specific names of people holding civic and religious authority in first century Palestine when "the word of God came to John the Baptist:" Tiberius Caesar, Pontius Pilate, Herod, Philip, Lysanias, Annas, Caiaphas, and Zechariah. All this is meant to help us see that God breaks into our history, into real human events. Jesus is no mere myth. He is the Word-which-breaks-in, in concrete moments, you might say. And now we anticipate his coming once again in our specific situations.

Advent challenge: Name as many civic and religious leaders who are in authority currently in your life. Now, name who the potential John the Baptists may be. A spouse? A friend? A podcaster? A work colleague who brings God's word to you? Spend a moment considering that this comprises the concrete, historical setting into which Christ wishes to come. Then, with these specifics in mind, pray: "Come, Lord Jesus. Come."

#### **FIRST READING:**


The prophet Baruch offers the Israelites in Babylonian exile a vision of hope in which their broken relationship with God will be fully restored. Is there a broken relationship you could help heal this Advent season?

#### **SECOND READING:**

Paul prays with joy over the partnership he experiences with the believers in Phillipi. What relationships in your life bring you joy?

#### GOSPEL

Luke is careful to place the activities of John the Baptist in their proper historical and political context, showing how God acts in human history. Can you think of a time in your personal history when you felt God present?



#### SAINT OF THE WEEK

St. Elizabeth of the Trinity (1880-1906) was a French mystic, a member of the Discalced Carmelites. In her writing, her fierce belief in the Trinity within us, reachable through contemplative prayer, and her deep wish that we embrace God's love by letting ourselves be loved are her powerful legacy.







Thanks to all who have been helping prepare the church for the celebration of the Nativity of The Lord. Our Art and Environment Ministry is decorating the inside of the Church and Commons as well and at the Shrine.

#### **Stewardship Verse for The Annunciation**

Our original parish church, now the National Shrine of Our Lady of Walsingham, is tied to the Annunciation. The Holy House of Nazareth, which is the location of the Gospel verse below, is the Holy House transported to Loreto, Italy in the late 1200's around the time of the fall of Jerusalem. The Shrine in Walsingham, England was Our Lady's gift to the English people in remembrance of her Fiat, her "yes" to God. That Shrine in England bore the exact dimensions of the Holy House of Nazareth/Loreto.

Our founding pastor, Father Thomas Walsh had a personal devotion to Our Lady of Walsingham and fulfilled his promise to her to build an American Shrine. Our parish devotion to Our Lady has its roots in this verse from todays optional memorial for Our Lady of Loreto:

"The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. Therefore the child to be born will be called holy, the Son of God. And behold, Elizabeth, your relative, has also conceived a son in her old age, and this is the sixth month for her who was called barren; for nothing will be impossible for God." Mary said, "Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord. May it be done to me according to your word." Lk 1:35-38


