

READINGS FOR THE WEEK



THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT

First Reading:

"This is what you shall tell the Israelites: I AM sent me to you." (Ex 3:14)

Psalm:

The Lord is kind and merciful. (Ps 103)

Second Reading:

These things happened to them as an example, and they have been written down as a warning to us, upon whom the end of the ages has come. (1 Cor 10:11)

Gospel:

"But I tell you, if you do not repent, you will all perish as they did!" (Lk 13:5)

PROFESSION OF FAITH

On all Sundays we together express a summary of the central truths of our Christian faith in the words of the Creed. The Church recommends that during the Sundays of Lent and Easter, we use the Apostles' Creed rather than the Niceno-Constantinopolitan Creed. The Apostles' Creed is the baptismal symbol of the Church. It was formulated from the questions asked those about to be baptized at the Easter Vigil and those same questions asked of us when renewing our baptismal promises. The words are few, but the mysteries they contain are great. Let us receive them with a sincere heart and be faithful to them.



GOSPEL MEDITATION

THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT

John 4:5-42

My childhood best friend was Xander Price. He was the fastest runner in school,



an excellent baseball player and Jewish. Though his family wasn't intensely religious, I felt totally at home with them despite our religious differences. Everything about their Judaism seemed to undergird and strengthen my own experience of being a Catholic. I knew they didn't believe in Jesus like my family did, but I intuited somehow that Jesus was "hiding" in their religion. Like a

cat moving under a blanket, ready to emerge at any moment, the Lord was hidden there in a special way.

In the Gospel for this third Sunday of Lent, Jesus says, "For if you had believed Moses, you would have believed me, for he wrote of me" (John 5:46). Stunning words, those. Moses wrote about Jesus. The way therefore that we come to know and believe in Jesus is to discover him lurking in Moses' writings. The Hebrew Scripture is the wonderful womb in which Jesus gestates within a host of images: Adam, Isaac, David, Melchizedek, the Temple, sacrificed lambs, prophets and so on. Right now, in your parish's OCIA program, soon-to-be baptized people are carefully studying where Jesus is in the writings of Moses, so that they may believe in him. This works for all of us, too, who wish to deepen our knowledge and love of Jesus.

Lenten challenge: Take some time to prayerfully study one of the images of Jesus listed above in the Old Testament. Identify which one you find compelling and consider why this is so. If you don't know where to start, begin with the prophet Jeremiah as an image of Jesus.

QUESTIONS OF THE WEEK

FIRST READING:

God reveals to Moses that He has heard the cry of His people, and He is coming to rescue them from slavery in Egypt. What prayer do you need answered from God?

SECOND READING:

Paul believed the mistakes of the Israelites in the desert serve as an example and a warning of what to avoid in our journey with God. How might you show gratitude to God this upcoming week of Lent?

GOSPEL:

Jesus taught one must repent to bear good fruit in life. Can you think of some good fruit you have borne from repenting?

(PRACTICING) CATHOLIC RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

MINI REFLECTION:

THE PATIENT GARDENER:

I have garden beds on the side of my house that I don't deserve.

When we bought the property, this was one of the features that was highlighted in the listing. "Professional landscaping! Tri-level garden beds that bask in the southern exposure!"

But I'm so terrible at weeding these garden beds — they become overgrown quickly, and I shudder to imagine what the previous owners would think of me if they drove by. I'm afraid they would write me off as lazy or disinterested, when really I'm just exhausted and busy. Every time I try to garden, one of my little assistant gardeners runs near the road and I must abandon the project to save them.

So, my husband, bless his heart, is the savior of these garden beds. He goes out there in the cool of the evening to pluck up the weeds that threaten to overtake this beautiful little garden. Patiently and tenderly, he restores it to a presentable state. Without him, they would be lost.

Perhaps I love these garden beds so much because I identify with them. If I were a garden, I would also be a mess, and people who have no time for messes would write me off as hopeless. We all need a savior to stick up for us, to come and quietly prune the unsightly growths that have taken root in our souls and turn the soil that has sat undisturbed for too long.

WHY DO WE DO THAT? - CATHOLIC LIFE EXPLAINED

MORTAL VERSUS VENIAL SIN

QUESTION:

What is the difference between mortal and venial sin?

ANSWER:


Sin is a deliberate thought, word, action, or omission contrary to God's law. Since the beginnings of the Church, sin has been distinguished by its gravity. "Grave matter" is traditionally defined by the Ten Commandments.

If a person commits a grave sin with full knowledge of the action's evil and with the complete consent of their will, this is a mortal sin. The effects of mortal sin are grave – the loss of sanctifying grace, which can be restored by a fresh outpouring of God's mercy in the sacrament of Reconciliation.

Venial sin does not fit one or more of these conditions (for example, a less serious matter still freely chosen or grave matter committed while under force or ignorance of God's law).

The effects of venial sin – while still damaging to the human heart and human society – are less severe. Even so, smaller sins build habits, which can obstruct our growth in virtue.

When we are serious about following Jesus, we should do our best to avoid all sin, whether large or small!





RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

WHY DO WE CONTINUE TO CLIMB THAT HILL DAY AFTER DAY FOR WATER, WHEN WE HAVE BEEN GIVEN EVERLASTING WATER BY THE ONE WHO CAME TO RECONCILE US TO THE FATHER?

Those seeking to be cleansed in baptismal waters at Easter go through Scrutinies "to uncover, then heal all that is weak, defective, or sinful in the hearts of the elect; to bring out, then strengthen all that is upright, strong, and good" (RCIA 141).

The story of the woman at the well speaks to all of us of everlasting water that heals us and gives us strength for the journey. There are those among us who long for this, but we who have been marked for Christ a long time ago already possess it. But too often we continue to climb high hills looking for something else to satisfy us.

The Samaritan woman leaves behind her container at the well when she leaves. for there is no reason for her ever to return. You and I have left our vessels at the well also. Stop climbing that hill.

Today, as you listen to the words of the Scrutiny prayers and ritual, let us be resolved to drink again from that everlasting water God has given to us.





STEWARDSHIP UPDATE

Did you know that Saint Bede has **endowment funds**? Not exactly sure what an endowment fund even is? One important aspect of our Catholic stewardship is to provide for future generations. An endowment fund can accomplish that mission. Unlike our offertory collection, which is used for immediate need, an endowment is held in an investment fund set aside for the long-term support of our parish. Our endowment funds were created to ensure that our parish is able to financially sustain our mission long into the future. Our endowment fund is intended to last forever. Gifts to our endowment fund are protected and never spent. As the market grows over time, the value of the gifts to our fund grows and produce earnings that can be used by our parish to meet current needs.

Our endowments currently are for Building Fund, Columbarium, Contingency, and General. Small distributions are made each year.



Anyone can add to our parish endowment fund at any time. Our endowment fund is held at the Catholic Community Foundation of the Diocese of Richmond and is invested and managed in accordance with Catholic values.
