## Registration time is here!

We hope that you will continue to be a part of our wonderful school community in the coming year. Our registration for 2025–2026 is now open! Please include any siblings that will be NEW students (for example new Kindergarten students). Please note that Kindergarten students need to be 5 years old by September 1st.

Our enrollment is increasing and most classes are close to capacity, especially next year's Kindergarten, 1st grade, 3rd Grade, 4th Grade, 7th Grade and 8th Grade classes.

If you will NOT be returning to St. Bartholomew next school year, please send an email ASAP to Mrs. Campbell, [ccampbell@stbirish.net](mailto:ccampbell@stbirish.net). This registration process is vital for our school and parish's budget planning for next year.

- FACTS account paid with \$0 balance after the last day of school, May 23rd.
- If a new Kindergarten student, must have attended the Kindergarten Round-Up.

A 2025-2026 Indiana Choice Scholarship could be worth up to \$6,650 for residents of Bartholomew County. \*\*Still awaiting final numbers from the Indiana Department of Education.

**New for 2025-2026:** All families Parishioners & Non-Parishioners will pay additional tuition not covered by the Choice Scholarship. Difference per student could be \$350 for Parishioners, \$1,050 for Non-Parishioners.

Fees **included** in tuition amounts above:

- Textbook Fees
- Technology Fees

Additional Fees **not included** in tuition amounts above:

- Annual enrollment \$60 per student
- Incidental expenses; field trips, lunch money, etc. All families must set up a FACTS payment account for incidental expenses.

A reminder that if your child passed I-READ in 2nd grade, they do not need to retake in 3rd grade.



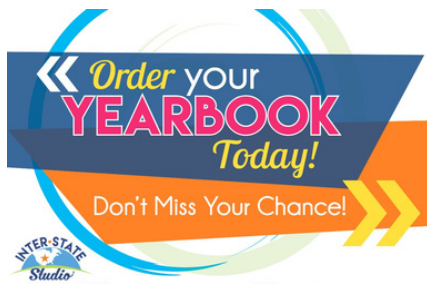

## INDIANA CHOICE SCHOLARSHIP NEWS

Currently the state of Indiana is in the process of reviewing the state budget and one item they are discussing is the Indiana Choice Scholarship. Currently the scholarship is based on your financial information, if you make less than the designated amount per family, you qualify. The state of Indiana is looking at moving to "universal" Choice which means income would no longer matter and you would just need to prove you live in Indiana. The Indiana general assembly does not get done until late April, so we won't know the outcome until then. But no matter what, Choice is an option, we are just not sure if it will be based on your income for next school year. More info to come with that!
