Incoming 7th and 8th Grade Summer Reading

- · All incoming 7th and 8th graders need to read one fiction and one nonfiction book with a minimum of 200 pages each.
- These should be "just right" books of their choice not too easy to read and not too hard.
- Parents, please use your discretion in allowing more mature titles.
- Students are to complete 20 signposts for each book. (See attached signpost sheets and signpost guidelines.)
- The 20 signposts should consist of a variety and should be distributed evenly throughout the reading.
- If a student chooses a book that is over 200 pages, he/she only needs to complete signposts on 200 pages.
- NOTE: Most students will use "fiction" or "narrative" signposts for <u>nonfiction</u> reading, as many will be reading "narrative" nonfiction.

The signposts are due on the first FULL day of school, Tuesday, August 23rd.

- · A Video Book Talk is due by Monday August 29th. Students are to choose one of the two books read and create a Video Book Talk <u>preferably with a partner</u>. (See attached instructions.) The Video Book Talk assignment will be posted in students' NEW Google Classroom accounts for the year 22-23. Students will need to join that new account in order to attach their book talk.
- · NOTE: Do not choose the following books: *The Giver, Warriors Don't Cry, The Outsiders* or *To Kill a Mockingbird*.
- · Students have done all these activities during the school year and should be familiar and confident with their work.
