The intermediate pool's purpose is to maintain the purchasing power of the underlying pool in perpetuity with additional emphasis on downside protection.


### Positioning

Federal Reserve officials recently voted to lift the federal funds rate by 25 bps to combat inflationary pressures. Officials indicated their intent to implement six more quarter-point hikes by the end of 2022. Median projections show the fed-funds rate rising to approximately 2.75% by the end of 2023. Meanwhile, Russia's invasion of Ukraine continues to dominate headlines. Market volatility has persisted as investors grapple with high inflation, tighter financial conditions, and geopolitical uncertainty.
