### The Pastor's Corner:

Dear Parishioners & Friends:

"Depart from me, Lord, for I am a sinful man." Our Gospel reading for this week features this searingly honest and powerful statement from Simon Peter once he sees the miracle catch and realizes that he is talking to the Lord. This statement really struck me as I reviewed the readings for this week. The Bible provides a mirror for us to see ourselves in the words and actions of the people in it, but this statement in particular resonates with me and should resonate with us all.

Because of original sin and the resultant brokenness of ourselves and the world, we are all sinners. Pope Francis, when asked to describe himself early in his papacy stated, "I am a sinner." It is an inescapable fact that, despite our best efforts and intentions, each and every one of us is the same – a sinner. This fact can often be wildly discouraging. In confession, I hear often from people who are frustrated and disillusioned by the fact that they keep committing the same sins over and over. There is a power,


