

Each one of us exists in very particular circumstances, in which, according to our own information, vision, perception, beliefs and state of consciousness, we respond. Those responses therefore reflect the understanding and relationship we have with all forms of life. This means that our responses are always conditioned by something or someone. The point is: what moves you when thinking, feeling or doing something? Your wishes? your whims? your ambition? your fantasies? your fears? your sorrows? your anxiety? your anger? Your love? your comprehension? All this is revealed or in a result of harmony or otherwise in a state of confusion. What is happening with me?

Todo esto se devela o en un resultado de armonía o en caso contrario en un estado de confusión. Que esta sucediendo conmigo?
