



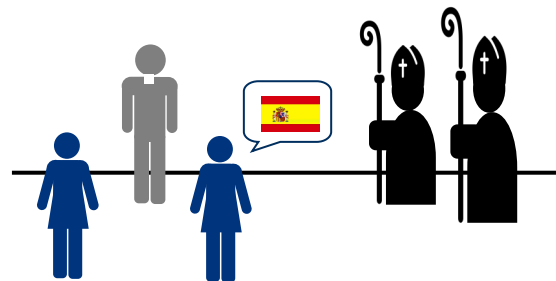

June-November 2022

Office of Synod Implementation:

Director, and two staff (including 1 bilingual)



Advisory Council:

Advises Bishop and Office of Synod Implementation on pastoral and theological matters

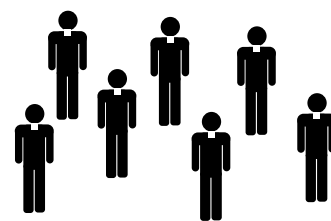
Archdiocesan Synod Implementation Team:

Role is to accompany, train and resource the Parish Synod Implementation Teams in cooperation with the Pastors.



Vicars for Evangelization:

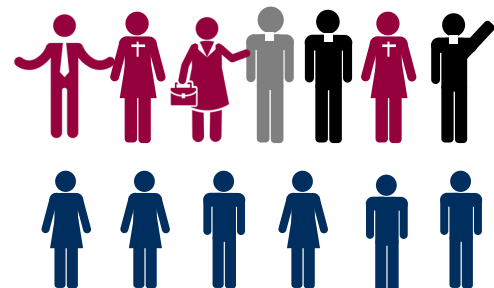
Provide encouragement and accountability through apostolic visits with respect to Synod Implementation.



Parish Synod Implementation Teams:

Pastor, in collaboration with his pastoral council and staff, chooses twelve to form his Synod Implementation Team ("SIT") Members:

- **Ex officio members:** Parochial Vicar, Deacon, School Principal, DRE, Discipleship and Evangelization Coordinator, and Parish Council delegate
- **Parishioners and staff:** Chosen at large, distinguished by their (i) proven charism of evangelization and/or (ii) potential to draw others to Christ.



Archbishop Hebda's Pastoral Letter



After considering the Recommended Pastoral Priorities, the Archbishop will write a Pastoral Letter, which will be published on the Feast of Christ the King (November 20, 2022).

Formation of Parish Implementation Teams Winter-Summer 2023

January:

In person kick-off event of the Parish Synod Implementation Teams.

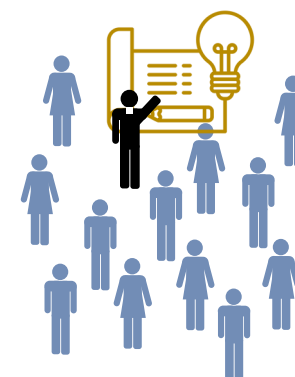


February-April:

Parish Synod Implementation Teams attend 8 session School of Discipleship training with subsequent 40 day challenge.

April/May:

Pastor and Parish Synod Implementation Teams Planning Day. Pastor and his team meet one weekend day to plan the upcoming year (2023/2024).



May-August:

S.I.T. members recruit potential Small Group Leaders.

Formation of Small Group Leaders Fall 2023

Training:

All parishes offer 7 session training sessions (via video) for Small Group Leaders.



Attendees:

All those identified as potential Small Groups Leaders as well as any interested parishioners.
