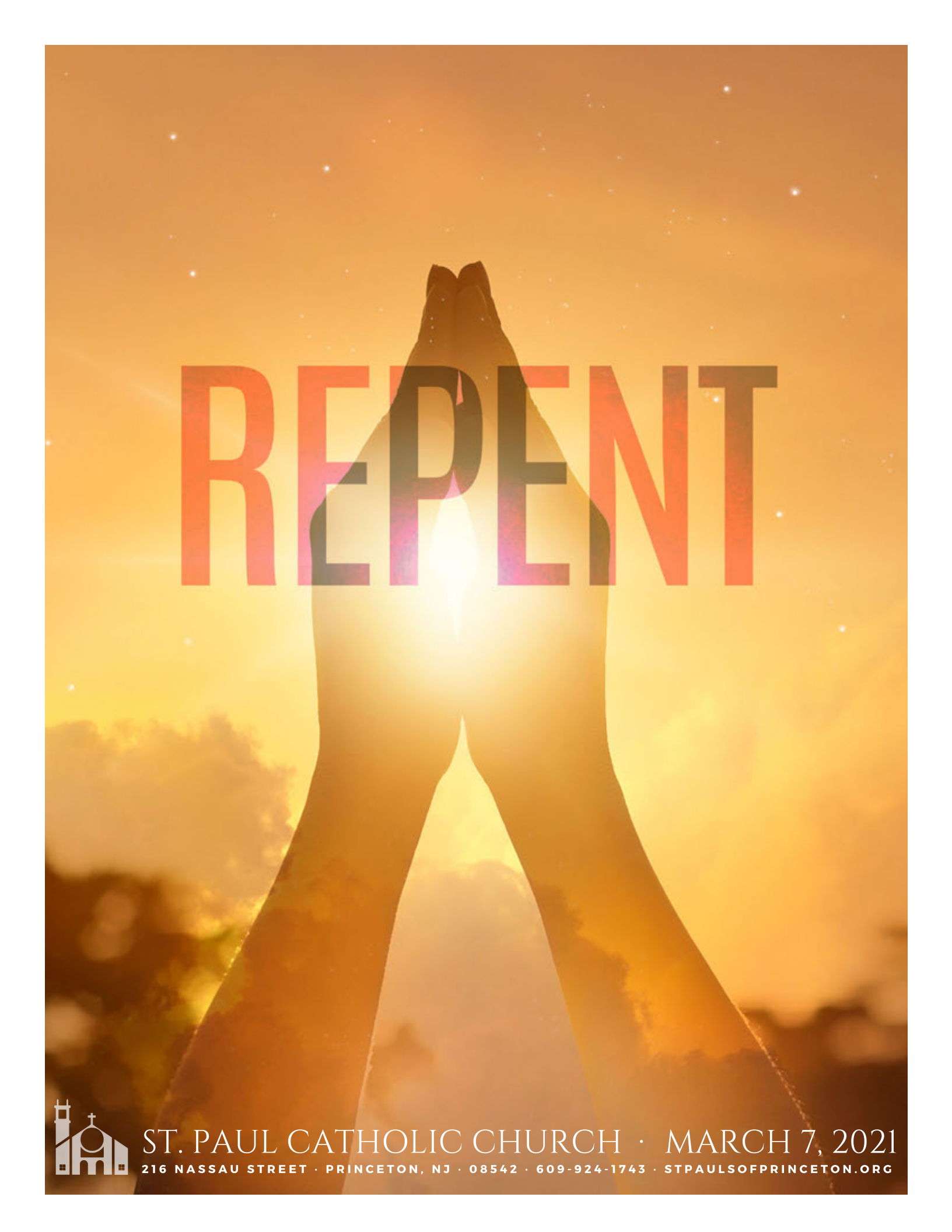

# WEEKLY CLERGY REFLECTION

Today's Gospel reading recalls a time when Jesus did some spring-cleaning to the Temple. He had come to Jerusalem to celebrate the Israelites' deliverance from Egypt centuries earlier. In order to purchase sacrificial offerings to make in the Temple, the Jews' own money needed to be exchanged for standard temple currency, turning the temple into a business rather than a house of worship. When Jesus saw this, anger rose within Him. Maybe you've seen a depiction of the scene: Jesus holding a whip, poised to strike, everyone around Him is confused, merchants are holding up their arms to protect themselves, tables are turned over, animals are running away, coins are spilled all over the place. In short, a confusing and chaotic scene.

As with the places we occupy physically – our homes, our cars, our offices – all need seasonal cleaning, so do our spiritual lives. With the passage of time, excess baggage, useless junk, and dust bunnies can start to accumulate in our physical spaces. Maybe the same thing happened to the temple. Certainly, the same can happen to our interior lives. Lent is a time to cleanse our temple.

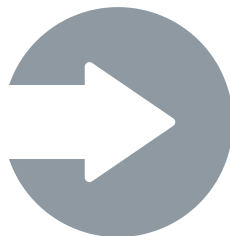
In cleansing, we do not simply hope for things to go away, but - as Jesus does - we resolvedly remove all the infidelities, sins, and distortions of our life. Today's readings from John's Gospel features Jesus cleansing the temple at the start of his ministry. Some scholars say that this cleansing happened twice while others say that these are two accounts of the same event. Whatever the case, we can never get enough cleansing. Clutter always accumulates and good things will eventually turn bad. Every life needs regular spring cleaning or may neglect to even notice the sin and clutter of our interior lives.

This is why we have the gift of this season of Lent: to help us clean out the temple of our lives to make a place where Christ is not a stranger. Is Christ at home in your life or does He seem to be a stranger? Lent is a time to be dramatic and decisive, to drive out the sin, the spiritual debris, and the clutter in the temple of our lives and make room for Christ.

## CAPACITY CHANGES FROM GOVERNOR MURPHY FEB 22, 2021

# FAITH FORMATION

## A MESSAGE FROM MR. JOHN MCGUIRE

As we continue with the practices, we associate with the Lenten season, we'll take this opportunity to consider **fasting**. Although it may seem counter-intuitive, fasting has become pretty trendy. It leads to focus, aligning the systems of the body. While secular participants might not realize it, those are two reasons we as Catholics practice fasting for spiritual benefit.

It's easy to get caught up on what we need for our body to function well. A next meal means sustenance, but can also be something we enjoy. We must remember that we are both body and soul. Often, we concern - even, preoccupy - ourselves with our bodily needs. Jesus told us even as he was tempted, "man does not live on bread alone, but every word that comes from the mouth of God." To survive and thrive we need food for our bodies, but we also need feed our spirit.

During Lent we are called to bring fasting to a whole new level by uniting it with prayer and alms giving. When we use fasting as a device to focus more on our prayer, it improves the quality of our connection with God. When skipping meals flows into our alms giving (or vice versa), we've no longer denied ourselves for our own sake, but out of love for those who are going without. Practically, that act could provide a meal for another.

This week let's pray that our fasting can lead us into a deeper experience of our faith, into deeper relationship with Jesus - who fasted to mark the beginning of His ministry.

## REFLEXIÓN DEL EVANGELIO

El evangelio presenta a Jesus arrojando a los vendedores del templo, narracion que San Juan pone al comienzo del ministerio publico de Jesus, inmediatamente despues de las bodas de Cana, porque debe ser vista desde la perspectiva del cambio y renovacion total del sistema religioso y social judio que Jesus venia a efectuar. Los jefes religiosos judios y los vendedores profanaban el templo haciendolo centro de negocios, discriminaciones y barreras; cada grupo tenia su lugar en el templo y no debia mezclarse con los demas: los gentiles se quedaban fuera; los proselitos, paganos convertidos al judaismo, junto a la puerta; las mujeres en su atrio y los hombres en el suyo; sacerdotes y levitas entraban en el patio interior; un sacerdote entraba en el edificio cada dia para ofrecer incienso; solo una vez al ano el sumo sacerdote entraba al interior, al Santo de los Santos, el Dia de la Expiacion o Yom Kippur. Aquel templo material debia ser reemplazado por Jesus en persona, en quien todos por igual tenemos acceso al Padre. Hay que quitar todas las barreras y descriminaciones que nos alejan unos de otros y que acaban alejandonos de Dios. Ademas, los sacerdotes habian profanado el templo montando todo un negocio economico en favor del Dios que mas amaban, el dinero o Mammon.

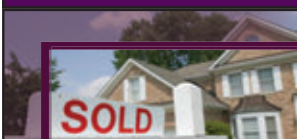
