





PARKING AT THE PARISH

for Mass and other weekend events

Cognizant of our limited parking here on our campus, we ask that all who come to Mass ensure you are parking in a single and marked spot. Please do not double park, park in handicapped spots unless authorized, or park in clergy/resident spots.



This traveling exhibit has been created to assist those who will experience it in affirming belief in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. It is based on the website created by Blessed Carlo Acutis to catalogue all the eucharistic miracles that have taken place worldwide.

The exhibit is circular and is divided into seven sections or rooms. In the first six rooms, information about the Eucharistic miracles is displayed. Each panel names a miracle, recounts the story of its occurrence, and the country where it took place. The panels are arranged in chronological order from the early Third Century to 2013. Be sure to notice the date on the timeline and some of the world events that will help you to place it within the historical era.

All of the rooms point to the center of the exhibit. This is to intentionally remind us that the historical miracles we are learning about on the walls of the exhibit are all pointing to the miracle in front of us—Jesus, present in the Most Holy Eucharist! In the seventh room, the Eucharist is clearly visible in the monstrance and a place has been prepared for you to rest a while in His presence.

"Only in God is my soul at rest" (Psalm 62:1)

A message from Mrs. Jaime Gostkowski

Back to Ordinary Time – But This Sunday Is Anything But Ordinary!

This week marks our return to Ordinary Time—but the next two Sundays are far from ordinary. These are solemnities—special days that focus on the deepest truths of our faith. This Sunday, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity: one God in three persons—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus speaks to his disciples at the Last Supper. He reassures them that even though he's leaving, they won't be alone. The Holy Spirit, the Spirit of Truth, will be with them—guiding and strengthening them for what's ahead.

The Trinity reminds us of perfect unity and unselfish love. That same love is meant to shape our lives—especially within our families.

Think of those everyday moments: a spouse quietly takes care of a chore, a child comforts a sibling, or you offer patience after a long day. These small, selfless acts reflect God's love. As parents and caregivers, we often give without expecting anything in return—just as God gives to us.

God didn't have to create us or send Jesus to save us—but He did, out of pure love. When we live that kind of love at home, we're not just being kind—we're living out the mystery of the Trinity in real, meaningful ways.

This "Ordinary Time" is a reminder that the love we show each day is anything but ordinary.
