## Cardinal Wilton Gregory Responds to Dobbs Ruling:

"Nearly 50 years ago when Roe v. Wade was handed down, our nation became a house divided against itself by putting freedom of choice before even the inalienable right of life itself. Since then, we have tirelessly prayed and worked for a restoration of the values stated in the Declaration of Independence that have made ours a truly great nation.

Human life is precious and sacred. With the Supreme Court's decision in Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization, now we can begin to heal those divisions that have so diminished us as a people and as a society.

We rejoice in this latest step in our journey, but our work is not done. Locally and nationally, we still have more to do to advance the dignity of human life and to make sure that the full range of life issues are adequately addressed. This includes supporting pregnant women in making life-affirming choices, providing better availability of prenatal and postnatal care for children and their mothers, advocating for affordable child care and safe schools, and advancing policies that support mothers in school and in the workforce.

We must also recognize that a life-affirming ethic should also draw attention to a host of other areas that should be of great concern to humanity. This includes revoking the death penalty and caring for the imprisoned; addressing all forms of injustice, including racism; caring for the poor, the sick, elderly, and vulnerable; and advancing a greater recognition of our calling in the entire spectrum of human relationships to be brothers and sisters to one another."


# El cardenal Wilton Gregory responde al fallo Dobbs:

"Hace casi 50 años, cuando se dictó el fallo Roe v. Wade, nuestra nación se convirtió en una casa dividida contra sí misma al anteponer la libertad de elección incluso al derecho inalienable de la propia vida. Desde entonces, hemos orado y trabajado incansablemente para restaurar los valores establecidos en la Declaración de Independencia que han hecho de nosotros una nación verdaderamente grande.

La vida humana es preciosa y sagrada. Con la decisión del Tribunal Supremo en el caso Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization, ahora podemos empezar a sanar esas divisiones que tanto nos han mermado como pueblo y como sociedad.

Nos alegramos de este último paso en nuestro camino, pero nuestro trabajo aún no ha terminado. A nivel local y nacional, todavía tenemos mucho por hacer para promover la dignidad de la vida humana y asegurarnos de que se aborde adecuadamente toda la gama de cuestiones relacionadas con la vida. Esto incluye apoyar a las mujeres embarazadas para que tomen decisiones que afirmen su opción por la vida, proporcionar una mayor atención prenatal y postnatal para los niños y sus madres, abogar por guarderías asequibles y escuelas seguras, y promover políticas que apoyen a las madres en la escuela y en la fuerza laboral.

También debemos reconocer que una ética que afirma la vida debe poner atención a otras áreas que deberían ser de gran preocupación para la humanidad. Esto incluye la revocación de la pena de muerte y el cuidado de los encarcelados; la lucha contra todas las formas de injusticia, incluyendo el racismo; el cuidado de los pobres, los enfermos, los ancianos y los más vulnerables; y fomentar un mayor reconocimiento de nuestra vocacióna de ser hermanas y hermanos entre nosotros, dentro de toda la variedad de las relaciones humanas."
