



St. Anthony Cemetery Rules

The safety of our families, visitors and groundskeepers is a priority of the Cemetery Board. The St. Anthony Cemetery should be a place for families to honor their loved ones in a well-kept and dignified setting. For these reasons, the following St. Anthony Cemetery Gravesite Rules are in place:

- 1) The gravesite is allowed one monument which must be placed on a footer. No additional statuary or garden stones are permitted. Shepherds' crooks may not be used during mowing season. They are allowed from November 15th to March 1st.
- 2) No live plantings are permitted on gravesites. Any landscaping ideas for the cemetery must be presented to the board for approval. Drawings to scale must be submitted.
- 3) No dirt, stones, or other fill may be added to the gravesite.
- 4) No glass items or other fragile items are permitted.
- 5) Alcoholic beverages are not permitted in the cemetery.
- 6) Clean up days are April 1st and October 1st. Any debris, trash and any other items from the previous season must be removed.
- 7) The cemetery staff may remove any flowers or décor that have become unsightly or are a maintenance problem as determined by staff. The families will not be notified in advance.
- 8) Solar-powered lights are permitted only if attached to the monument.
- 9) Balloons are not allowed as décor and there will be no helium balloon releases.
- 10) The cemetery is open from dawn to dusk.
- 11) The Cemetery Board disclaims all responsibility for loss or damage from causes beyond its reasonable control, and especially from damage by an act of God, the elements, civil disorder, unavoidable accidents, or any cause similar or dissimilar beyond the control of the Board, whether the damage be direct or collateral.
- 12) When any damage is discovered, the Parish office will contact the holder of record to have the damages repaired in a timely fashion. Claims should be turned in to the holder's home/renter's insurance company.
