From the Pastor



“Zacchaeus, come down quickly, for today I must stay at your house.” *Luke 19:5* Zacchaeus was up a tree, because practically speaking, he was short and wanted to see Jesus as He passed by. Yet there is far greater meaning revealed in the symbolism.

This is a fascinating Gospel passage. Zacchaeus was a wealthy and well respected man. In the eyes of the world he was successful. But despite his wealth, it appears there was something missing. He heard about Jesus and desired to know more about Him. It must have been an unusual sight to see a wealthy and successful man climbing a tree in the presence of a large crowd. In fact, it was so unusual that Jesus immediately noticed it.

Jesus also noticed something more significant than just a grown man climbing a tree. Zacchaeus was noticed primarily because Jesus was able to perceive the desire and openness of his heart. Zacchaeus, this wealthy and successful man, was missing something and he was zealous to obtain it. He longed for Jesus and this desire is fulfilled by the compassion of our Lord.

Regardless of whether or not you are “successful” from a worldly point of view, it is essential that you, too, recognize the unfulfilled desire of your heart. That “unfulfilled desire” refers to any way in which God is not fully the center of your life. Some people try to fulfill this desire in different worldly ways. But those who are like Zacchaeus will realize that Jesus is the answer. And when someone recognizes this fact, they will go to any length necessary to see Him and be with Him.

Reflect, today, upon a simple question: How far am I willing to go to see Jesus? Are you willing to do anything you have to so as to see Him, hear Him and be with Him? It may take an act of humility and you may have to act in a radical way. Doing so will call out to the heart of our Lord and He will respond to you with much generosity just as He did to Zacchaeus.

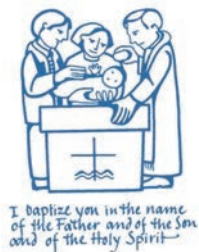

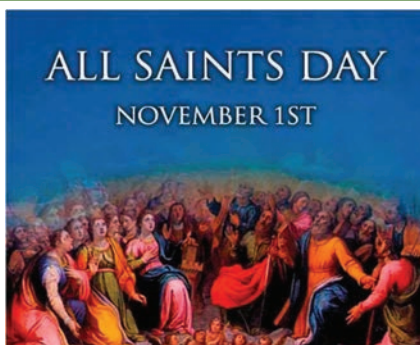

The final major choral masterworks composed by Mozart and Beethoven, performed on our Steinway D Model.

The Choral Fantasy by Beethoven is noted as a forerunner to the later Ninth Symphony. The Ode To Joy is a clear descendent of the principal theme of the Choral Fantasy and radiates a similar optimism about the human condition, a most engaging, vibrant, and moving work. Structured as a piano concerto, the chorus enters in the final quarter with an exuberant tribute to the harmony of life, the power of music, and the gift of art.

The Requiem of Mozart is one of the most famous musical compositions ever written. Its fame comes not only from the music itself, but also from the story of its composition. Fans of the Oscar-winning 1984 film Amadeus will remember the scene in which Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart, on his deathbed, dictates unfinished parts of the Requiem to his rival Salieri.

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
