We will be capping our 3K class at 20 students and we have 12 students preregistered already! This event is geared toward new families, however the teachers have used the time to move the 3K & 4K students up and visit the teacher they would have next year.

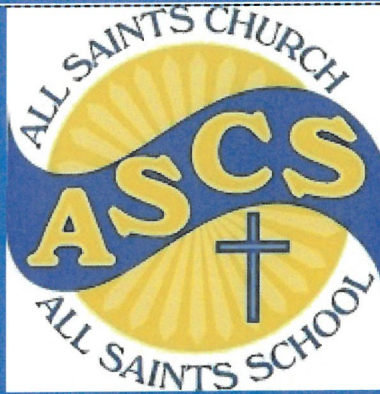
