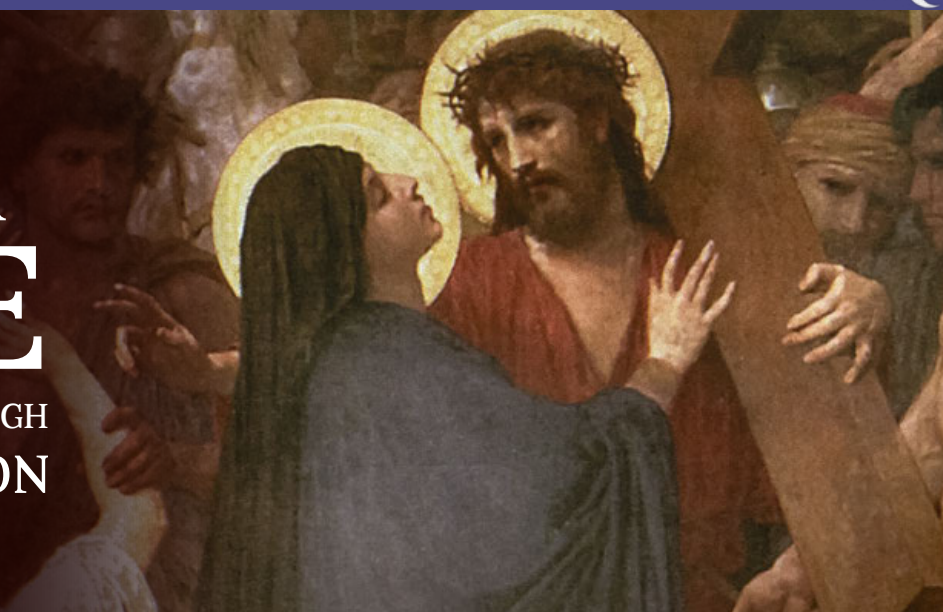

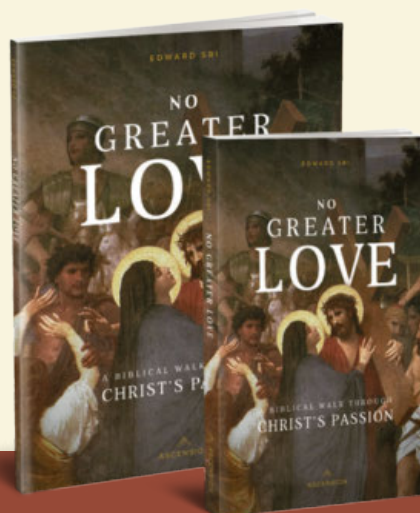

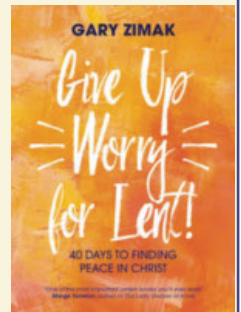


Women's Ministry Lenten Book Study

Cash & Carry/RaiseRight Order News

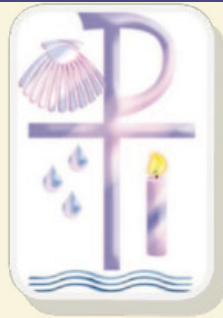
The RaiseRight/Sharing Program is a fundraiser for the school. The school purchases gift cards at a discount. Families can purchase gift cards either online or in person at face value. Once a family signs up for the program, each quarter they will receive a rebate based on their purchases. The school earns 50% of the percentage and the family receives 50% towards their tuition. For those participating that do not have children in the school, you can designate a student to donate your rebate to, or receive a check. Example of a purchase: \$100 gift card bought by the school at a 10% discount. The family would receive \$5.00 toward their rebate and the school would earn \$5.00.

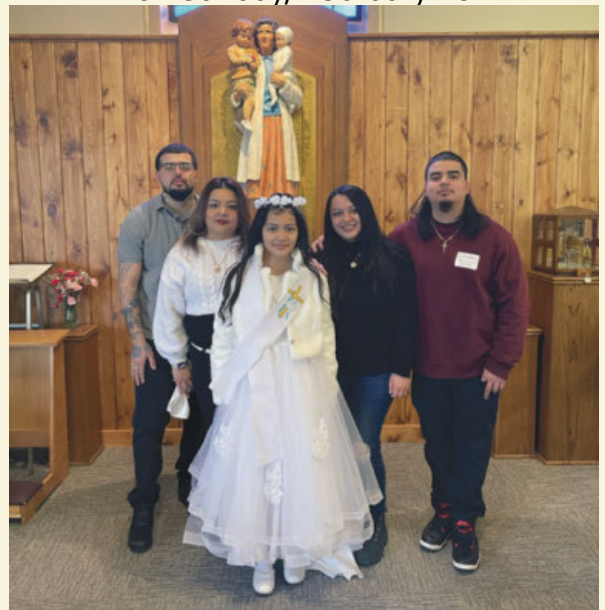

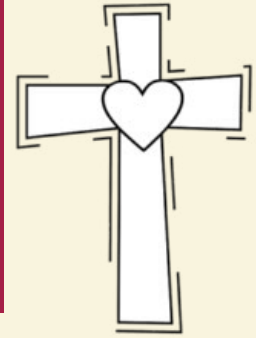

Jubilee 2025: Pilgrims of Hope

Pope Francis has declared 2025 to be a Jubilee Year within the Church. Jubilee Years are years set aside to encourage us to seek God's mercy, to renew the focus on our spiritual life, or even embark on a pilgrimage. This Jubilee Year, Pope Francis has asked us to reflect on God's boundless mercy and embrace our mission to live out the Gospel in everyday life.

Cardinal Cupich opened the Jubilee Year locally by celebrating Mass at Holy Name Cathedral on December 29, 2024, at 12:30 p.m. Throughout the year, from December 29, 2024 through December 28, 2025, all will be invited to participate in the Jubilee by visiting designated Pilgrimage Sites. The Archdiocese has designated 24 churches and missions as Pilgrimage Sites, including St. Gianna. We are pleased to join with the Universal Church in prayer and pilgrimage throughout the year. Pope Francis has granted special indulgences to those who participate in the celebration of the Jubilee. The indulgence, a priceless gift of divine mercy, is one of the special 'signs' of the Jubilee Year. 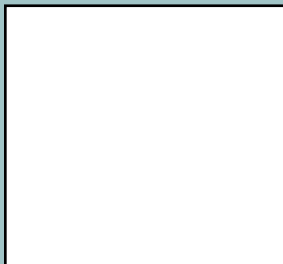

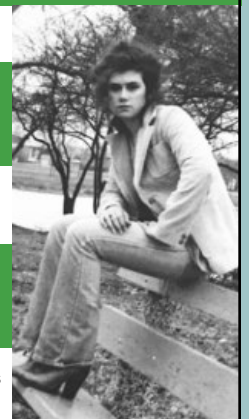

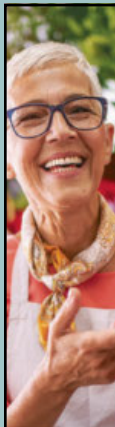
