From Father Mike

In today's first reading, Eli had to teach Samuel to understand the source of the voice that he was hearing and how to respond to it. When he finally is able to answer, "Speak, for your servant is listening," (1 Samuel 3:10), the passage ends with the observation that "Samuel grew up, and the LORD was with him, not permitting any word of his to be without effect." (1 Samuel 3:19). As we move through this month of January, we are invited to listen attentively to God's Word and respond in a way that reflects the effect of this Good News on our lives. Much of our response is in the form of prayer that comes from hearts that are authentically desiring an awareness of God's presence among us and that are repentant for when we have not reflected that fully to others. Those opportunities referred to in other parts of this bulletin and via our online resources include praying for Christian Unity (Jan. 18-25), for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children (Jan. 22), the Nine Days for Life (Jan. 22-29), and Word of God Sunday (Jan. 24). As we also pray for our newly elected government officials for peace throughout our land, and for the health and safety of all, we seek to listen to God's voice calling us to listen to him as we continue to follow Jesus, the very Word made human and continuing to dwell in our midst.

En la primera Lectura de hoy, Elí tuvo que enseñarle a Samuel a comprender la Fuente de la voz que estaba escuchando y cómo responder a ella. Cuando finalmente puede responder: "Habla, Señor; tu siervo te escucha" (I Samuel 3, 10), el pasaje termina con la observación de que "Samuel creció y el Señor estaba con él. Y todo lo que el Señor le decía, se cumplía." (I Samuel 3, 19). A medida que avanzamos en este mes de enero, se nos invita a escuchar atentamente la Palabra de Dios y a responder de una manera que refleje el efecto de esta Buena Nueva en nuestras vidas. Gran parte de nuestra respuesta es a través de una oración que proviene de corazones que desean auténticamente una conciencia de la presencia de Dios entre nosotros y que se arrepienten cuando no lo hemos reflejado plenamente en los demás. Esas oportunidades a las que se hace referencia en otras partes de este boletín y a través de nuestros recursos en línea incluyen la oración por la Unidad Cristiana (18 – 25 de enero), los nueve días a favor de la vida (22 de enero). – 29) y Domingo de la Palabra de Dios (24 de enero). Al orar también por la paz en toda nuestra tierra, por nuestros funcionarios gubernamentales recién elegidos y por la salud y seguridad de todos, buscamos escuchar la voz de Dios que nos llama a escucharlo mientras seguimos a Jesús, la misma Palabra hecha humana y que continúa habitando entre nosotros.
