From Father Mike

You will be reading soon in the *Catholic Moment*, the diocesan newspaper, about one of the new aspects of *Uniting in Heart*, namely the extensive leadership training that is now required for priests and staff personnel. Our Director of Operations, Heather Tokarz, and I have attended four sessions on navigating change, conversational intelligence, listening styles, and conflict dynamics. The last one covered different ways in which you can identify and constructively work through various types of conflict. It was a helpful reminder that a healthy parish is one that addresses conflicts, not one that avoids them or pretends like they do not exist. Especially in this early phase of implementing the *Uniting in Heart Pastoral Plan*, I have appreciated all the feedback you offer, including questions and struggles that you have amidst all this change. The respect and openness of this communication acknowledges that we are working through the conflict of moving away from the way things were before and now figuring out what our life can be like as a pastorate. Like any healthy marriage, family, or community, engaging in the dynamics of an evolving relationship takes effort, courage, and patience. And we Christians do this, it is how we live out the nature of God himself, who is a communion of love between the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. So on this Solemnity of the Holy Trinity, let us invoke the name of the God who is Three Persons in perfect unity as we all strive to grow in love in all our relationships and seek to resolve any conflict along the way.

Muy pronto leerá en nuestro periódico diocesano llamado el *Catholic Moment*, acerca de uno de los nuevos aspectos de nuestro plan diocesano *Unidos de Corazón*, en cuanto a la amplia capacitación en liderazgo que ahora se requiere para los sacerdotes y el personal que les colabora. Nuestra Directora de Operaciones, Heather Tokarz, y yo hemos tomado parte de cuatro sesiones relacionadas a cómo navegar a través del cambio, la inteligencia conversacional, los estilos de escucha y la dinámica de conflictos. Este último cubrió diferentes formas en las que se puede identificar y trabajar constructivamente a través de varios tipos de conflicto. Fue un recordatorio útil de que una parroquia saludable es aquella que se ocupa de los conflictos, no una que los evita o finge que no existen. Especialmente en esta fase inicial de implementación del *Plan Pastoral Unidos de Corazón*, he apreciado todos los comentarios que ofrecen, incluidas las preguntas y retos que experimentan durante todo este cambio. El respeto y la franqueza de esta comunicación reconoce que estamos trabajando en el conflicto de alejarnos de la forma en que eran las cosas antes y descubrir cómo puede ser nuestra vida como Pastorado ahora. Como cualquier matrimonio, familia o comunidad saludable, participar en la dinámica de una relación en evolución requiere esfuerzo, valentía y paciencia. Los cristianos hacemos esto, así es como vivimos la naturaleza de Dios mismo, que es una comunión de Amor entre el Padre, el Hijo y el Espíritu Santo. Entonces, en esta Solemnidad de la Santísima Trinidad, invoquemos el nombre del Dios que es Tres Personas en perfecta unidad mientras todos nos esforzamos por crecer en el amor en todas nuestras relaciones y buscamos resolver cualquier conflicto en el camino.

BISHOP'S DECREE ON SUNDAY MASS

Effective June 11, the general dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass is hereby lifted. Except for the unique situations as described below, those who are otherwise healthy are obliged to return to Sunday Mass by the weekend of June 12-13, 2021:

- Those who are seriously ill, exhibit flu-like symptoms and/or may have a contagious disease (including quarantine due to exposure).
- Those who are unable to attend Mass through no fault of their own (e.g. transportation issue).
- Those who are homebound and/or incapacitated due to age, infirmity and/or medical restrictions.
- Those who have compromised health conditions and/or at high risk of contracting the virus.
- Those who are caretakers of person who are sick or of persons at high-risk of serious illness if they contract Covid virus.

If you have any questions about any specific needs, concerns or protocols, you are advised to contact your parish directly. Your pastor, who has the authority to dispense in individual cases, may be helpful in addressing individual fears and concerns.

DECREDO DEL OBISPO SOBRE LA MISA DOMINICAL

A partir del 11 de junio, se levanta la dispensa general de la obligación de asistir a Misa. Salvo las situaciones singulares que se describen a continuación, las personas sanas están obligadas a acudir a la misa dominical a partir del fin de semana del 12-13 de junio de 2021:

- Quienes estén gravemente enfermos, presenten síntomas gripales o puedan tener una enfermedad contagiosa (esto incluye la cuarentena por exposición).
- Los que no pueden asistir a la misa por causas ajenas a su voluntad (por ejemplo, por problemas de transporte).
- Las personas confinadas en casa o incapacitadas por edad, enfermedad o restricciones médicas.
- Aquellos que tienen afecciones de salud que los pongan en riesgo de contraer el virus.
- Las personas que cuidan de enfermos o de personas con alto riesgo de enfermarse de gravedad si contraen el virus de la COVID-19.

Si tiene alguna pregunta sobre alguna necesidad, preocupación o protocolo específico, le recomendamos que se ponga en contacto directamente con su parroquia. Su párroco, quien tiene la autoridad para otorgar la dispensa en casos
