

### A Note From Your Parish Nurse: Watch your weight!

To stay at a healthy weight, balance the calories you eat with the calories you burn. To lose weight, you need to burn more calories than you eat. A healthy diet and physical activity can help you control your weight. You burn more calories when you are physically active. If you are overweight, losing weight can lower your risk for serious health conditions like: Type 2 diabetes, heart disease, high blood pressure, and early death.

#### Take Action!

Start by making a promise to eat well, move more, and get support from family and friends.

-Set realistic goals: If you need to lose weight, do it slowly over time. 1-2 pounds/week.

-Keep a food and activity diary: When you know your habits, it's easier to make changes.

-Eat healthy

-Eat smaller portions

-Get more physical activity: Try to be active for 30 minutes 5 times a week. Even some activity is better than none. If you don't have time for 30 minutes of activity, get moving for shorter 10 minute periods throughout the day.
