


Last Supper by

**FROM THE CHURCH OFFICE**

**God is Love, Give God Glory**

Earlier this week I was subbing in the first-grade class at St. A, and I found myself teaching the religion lesson (thanks, Mrs. Holliday!). I have to admit that my first degree is in elementary education. I student taught in second grade and was a teaching assistant for kindergarten. I never taught religion with elementary children, but I did teach high school theology. The wonderful thing is that the subject was about giving God glory.

What does 'glory' mean? One young man, to whom I am not related, told the class that to give God glory means to honor God, another said it means to show respect. One little girl said it is how we praise God. Thomas Aquinas would probably tell us it is to recognize God as the Primary Cause. The First Graders have a good foundation; they get it.

Bewilderment was present when I asked, "How does grass give God glory?" Most of them thought this was an odd question since all grass does is grow or die. If grass is growing and verdant, does that not please God? We read Psalm 148 and found that all elements, indeed all of creation gives glory to God. The main question then becomes, how do we give glory to God. This is our quest; this is our destiny. As one created by God, each of us must give glory to God. Why?

Jesus tells his disciples that they are to love one another as he has loved them. Jesus' love for the disciples is not mere lip service. He has devoted all his energy to being present to people in need and has spent years on mission. He knew his destiny, and he came face to face with the challenge of continuing the journey to the end, or rather to a new beginning. We experience the joy of the resurrection when we leave ourselves behind and look to God. We discern how we will each give glory to God, and we share with others. Even when we experience sadness, grief or fear, we love others because that is how we love God. God loves us into existence, and we return that love by giving God praise, honor and respect. Love impels us to love. To God be the glory!
