Gospel Justice and Environmental Justice are now one ministry. In the spirit of our Holy Father, Francis, we will be publishing a weekly meditation based on Pope Francis recent encyclical letter, "*Fratelli Tutti*": (All Brothers and Sisters Together,)

Written when the Covid clouds were dark, it is a solemn reminder of how all of us human beings are made in God's image and are thus interconnected. This was the hard lesson brought home to each of us by the pandemic—our utter interdependence on one another under God. Pope Francis begins his encyclical with this quote:

"*Fratelli tutti.*" With these words, St. Francis of Assisi addressed his brothers and sisters and proposed to them a way of life marked by the flavor of the Gospel. Of the counsels Francis offered, I would like to select the one in which he calls for a love that transcends the boundaries of geography and distance, and declares blessed all those who love their brother 'as much when he is far away with him as when he is with him'." *Fratelli Tutti*, 1

August 8, 2021—
19th Sunday of Ordinary Time:



In today's Gospel, Jesus says, "I am the living bread that came down From heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world." The love that Jesus reveals through the symbol of bread is: self-giving, sacrificial, healing, forgiving, unifying, loyal to one's friends, powerless, in solidarity with the weak, confident in the power of God.

Pope Francis has written, "The measure of the greatness of a society is found in the way it treats those most in need, those who have nothing apart from their poverty." All Catholics — all Christians -- are called to stand "in solidarity with the weak." As our Holy Father reminds us in *Laudato Si'*, his encyclical on the environment, those who will suffer most from the effects of climate change and ecological degradation are the poor. In recent months, severe weather conditions such as drought, heat waves, and fires up and down the west coast, devastating floods in Europe, and increasingly powerful hurricanes in the Atlantic, have made the imminent threat of global climate change more readily apparent. It has become abundantly clear that the danger to all of us, and particularly to the poorest of the poor, is no longer simply a scientific prediction but a fact. During these hot summer months many of the needy, especially the elderly, or infirm, often come to St. James Vincentians for assistance with utility bills. Your generosity helps us help them.

Entering One Another's Joys and Sorrows

God, in His longing for His children to enjoy freedom from the control of sin, sent His Son, the *Bread of heaven* to Earth to nourish and reveal to us how Oneness with the God of love frees us from fear and anxiety. In His humility, Jesus entered the joys and sufferings of all whom he met. Jesus' admonition to "Follow me" means acting on His revelation of vulnerability and trust. Jesus showed us not only how to give of ourselves by entering the lives of our neighbors but also shows how vulnerability allows others to enter our lives.

Consider Jesus, on the cross, suffering from injustice, selfishness, hatred, jealousy, and fear in the world. Yet, even as he hung on the cross he was not abandoned. The women who had accompanied Jesus in his preaching, healing, and forgiving, continued to accompany Jesus to the cross. Just as Jesus had entered their lives and brought them to the freedom of love of God they now, in their vulnerability and trust surpassed mourning and freely entered his suffering - the cost of a relationship in the Oneness of Jesus and one another. These same patient women also entered the joy of being the ones to announce the Resurrection.

Like these women, throughout our lives, we sin, we repent, we convert our lives to enter the living Oneness with God— the Bread of Life come down from heaven.

FEAST OF FAITH

Sanctus, Sanctus, Sanctus: Song of Heaven

The words of the Sanctus are rooted in the scriptures. They recall the song of the seraphim in the prophet Isaiah's vision of God in majesty: "Seraphim were stationed above; each of them had six wings: with two they veiled their faces, with two they veiled their feet, and with two they hovered aloft. 'Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of hosts!' they cried one to the other. 'All the earth is filled with his glory!' " (Isaiah 6:2-3). They recall the Gospel accounts of Jesus' entry into Jerusalem: "Hosanna to the Son of David; blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord; hosanna in the highest" (Matthew 21:9). Yet the liturgy adds something new to these ancient texts. The seraphim sang, "the earth is filled with his glory." But the liturgy proclaims, "heaven and earth are full of your glory." In the Eucharist, earth and heaven meet. For a moment in time, we join in the song that the angels sing for all time. The Sanctus raises us to heaven, but does not remove us from the earth. It is the song of the King who took on our human flesh so that we might share in his divine life.

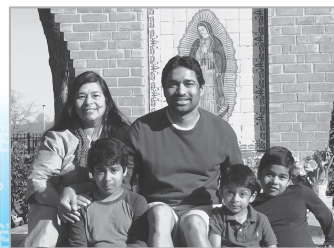
