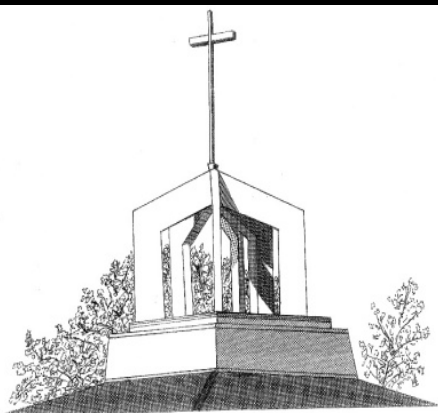

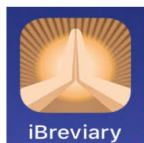

GOD WANTS TO BE ONE WITH US

What great lengths God will go to in loving and saving us! Think of the most outlandish circumstance you might conceive. That seems to be what the Lord is saying to Ahaz in today's first reading. "A virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall name him Emmanuel." Not only is the idea of a virgin conceiving beyond comprehension in Ahaz's time, so would the concept of God wanting to be with us be, as the name Emmanuel indicates. And yet, this is what we celebrate in the Incarnation—God wants so completely to be one with us that God came to be with us in a son born to a virgin, the Blessed Virgin Mary. There is more to this story than even these amazing and outlandish occurrences, however. God wants to be one with us so deeply that God partners with us to make God's presence known.



In today's Gospel, we hear that Jesus will be named Emmanuel, "God with us." The mystery of Jesus's birth is supremely a mystery of love. Jesus was born during the darkest time of the year. The Savior of the world came for the people in dark places. The real, lasting, and deep joy is that the Light shines there.

Christmas time is often called the "Season of Light" or the "Season of Joy." Those in desperate need more often experience a "Season of Despondency and Suffering." Dorothy Day once wrote, "Compassion – it is a word meaning to suffer with. If we all carry a little of the burden, it will be lightened. If we share in the suffering of the world, then some will not have to endure so heavy an affliction. It evens out." Again, this year, St. James parishioners demonstrated their compassion by donating generously in support of Vincentian programs. May God bless each of our donors and make their Christmas one of light and joy. As we have noted before, 2022 was a financially demanding year for our conference, and, as always, donations from generous St. James supporters have allowed us to help solve the financial problems of our needy neighbors. Gaudium et spes, a central Vatican II document, notes that "The future of humanity lies in the hands of those who are strong enough to provide coming generations with reasons for living and hope." Those who reach out to the poor may make this Christmas season and the months to come a "Season of Hope." May God bless each of our donors and make their Christmas season one of Light, Joy, and Hope.

School-Parish Connection December 18-19, 2022

On November 16, 30 seventh and eighth graders from elementary schools in the Diocese of Sacramento convened at St. James School for the annual speech contest. For more than two decades, the Diocesan speech contest has brought schools together to share their carefully-honed speeches. This year's topic asked students to research and learn more about Blessed Carlo Acutis. Blessed Carlo, a Catholic Italian teenager who died from leukemia in 2006, was beatified on October 10, 2020 in Assisi. He was a gamer and computer programmer who loved soccer and the Eucharist. Blessed Carlo once said, "All people are born as originals, but many die as photocopies." Speech contest participants were asked to speak to his life and, most importantly, focus on this quote and what it means, particularly as this generation is enveloped in social media. The poise, elocution, and confidence of these junior high students was truly amazing. I would like to recognize Santiago Ortigas and Samantha Morrill for their fantastic participation. Their speeches and the manner in which they presented were amazing! We are truly blessed to have such talented Falcons at St. James School!

DIOS QUIERE SER UNO CON NOSOTROS

Hasta dónde llega Dios para amarnos y salvarnos. Piensa en la circunstancia más descabellada que puedas concebir. Eso parece ser lo que el Señor le dice a Ajaz en la primera lectura de hoy. “Una virgen concebirá y dará a luz un hijo, y le pondrá el nombre de Emmanuel”. No sólo la idea de que una virgen conciba es incomprensible en la época de Ajaz, sino que también lo sería el concepto de que Dios quiera estar con nosotros, como indica el nombre Emmanuel. Y, sin embargo, esto es lo que celebramos en la Encarnación: Dios quiere ser uno con nosotros hasta tal punto que vino a estar con nosotros en un hijo nacido de una virgen, la Santísima Virgen María. Sin embargo, hay más en esta historia que estos sucesos sorprendentes y extravagantes. Dios quiere ser uno con nosotros tan profundamente que se asocia con nosotros para dar a conocer su presencia.

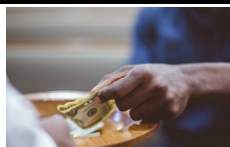
