

Starting March 1st (the day before Ash Wednesday), Fr. Gustavo is asking the entire St. Luke's Community to partake in a Marian consecration.

There is no doubt these last couple years have left many of us in a state of uncertainty. With the pandemic, the state of the world, families and communities divided, and the growth of anxiety and fear it is easy to get distracted by the noise of the secular world. During this Lent let us try to re-center our focus on Jesus, and what better way than through His mother. So what exactly is a Marian Consecration?

It is the act of entrusting one's body, soul, possessions, works, and entire life to the protection, guidance, and intercession of Our Lady.

Consecration is really about getting out of our own way and letting God be in charge. We consecrate ourselves to Jesus through Mary. There have been countless testimonies of people who have done consecrations. Stories of loved ones returning to the church, broken marriages healed, loved ones saved. If we did this as a community imagine what that would look like for our parish!

Starting March 1st, (the day before Ash Wednesday) all the way to The Passion on Good Friday we will begin our Marian Retreat. We are asking all parishioners, and all ministries to partake. We will follow the book *Mary's Mantle a Spiritual Retreat for Heavens Help* which has been endorsed by Bishop Myron Cotta. We will say the Rosary every day and each week come together each Monday evenings during Lent in the church to share in our journeys.
