Sunday Celebration in the Absence of a Priest

Years ago the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops authorized a Sunday service when it was not possible for a priest to be present to a parish community. The ability to do this then must be approved in each case by the local bishop of the diocese. This need arose in light of the priest shortage and wanting the faithful to be able to gather, to hear the Word of God and to receive Holy Communion on Sunday. As you know, we have had to cancel Sunday mass three times due to weather this winter. Therefore, I have requested Bishop Mueggenborg's approval to prepare and appoint someone in the parish to lead a Sunday Celebration in the Absence of a Priest. The bishop has granted this request and so I have worked with Judy Allen to prepare her to lead this special service should it become necessary. Judy is a long time member of the parish, member of the Pastoral Council and a Eucharistic Minister, among many other things for our parish. In the event a priest cannot make it up the hill for mass he will contact Judy who is prepared to lead this service. This is not something that will be scheduled to happen, but only in an emergency when a priest cannot come. It will satisfy one's obligation for mass, although it is important to understand that it is NOT a mass, it is a special service created for this unusual circumstance. Special thanks to Judy for being willing to do this. Remember, that if it is unsafe for you to come to mass due to severe weather you are not obligated to do so. However, it is important to honor the Day of the Lord by prayer and reflection, even if at home.
