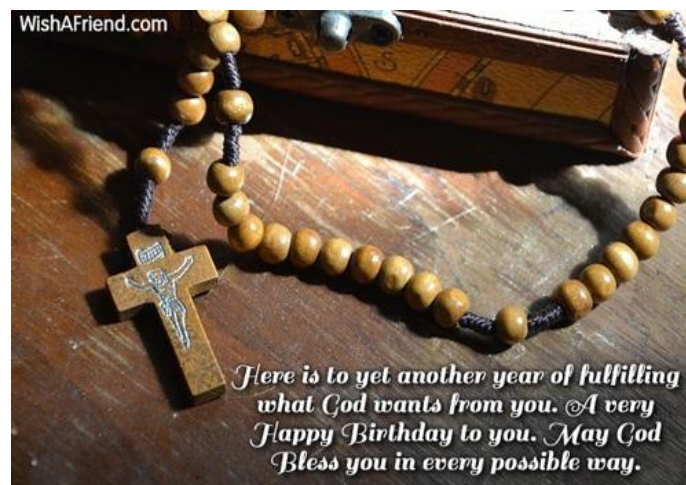
WELCOME

Hurricane Ida

As we continue to stand in solidarity and pray for those communities that have been impacted by Hurricane Ida, Most Reverend José H. Gomez, President of the USCCB, has asked the Faithful to consider giving to the Bishops Emergency Disaster Fund.

Funds will be used to support the USCCB for pastoral and reconstruction needs of the Church, as well as the efforts of Catholic Charities USA and/or Catholic Relief Services, as they and their local agencies respond to immediate emergency needs and aid in long-term rebuilding and recovery efforts.
