SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT

The gospel of the Transfiguration features this Sunday, it is always placed at this point in Lent. St. Matthew's version is used this year. The ascent to the top of the mountain illustrated the high point of faith—reaching the summit of belief.

"Peter spoke to Jesus, 'Lord,' he said, 'it is wonderful for us to be here,; if you wish, I will make three tents here, one for you, one for Moses and one for Elijah,' He was still speaking when suddenly a bright cloud covered them with shadow, and from the clous there came a voice which said, 'This is my Son, the Beloved; he enjoys my favour. Listen to him.'

But there is a mixture of highs and lows in life, and this is referred to when the apostles descend the mountain. Lent provides a focus to assess where we have come from and to readjust if necessary to continue this journey.

In faith, we do not build a tent to capture the experience once and for all. Rather, we allow it to form the foundation and basis for the rest of the journey.

Our Lenten talks continue on Tuesday on the theme of <u>Apocalyse Tomorrow?</u> Apocalypse is a word that can cause fear but it's true meaning is an unfolding, a revealing of mysteries. This week Sean Goan will speak on "Faith in Jesus Christ and apocalyptic thinking today". It should be interesting and stimulating, as was last Tuesday's talk by Dr. Julia McKinley on how apocalyptic texts in the Bible open up multiple insights.
