Tabernacle



The **Tabernacle** is the home for the Body of Christ.

Paschal Candle



The **Paschal Candle** is blessed on Easter and lit to represent the light of Christ.

Saint Mary Statues



Saint Mary, also called the Blessed Mother, is the mother of Jesus and wants to bring us closer to her Son.

Can you find them both in St. Patrick's?

St. Joseph Statues



Saint Joseph is the foster father of Jesus.

Can you find both statues?

Altar



The Altar is the table on which the Sacrifice of the Eucharist is offered.

Holy Water Font



Blessing ourselves from the **Holy Water Font** reminds us of our baptism.

Baptismal Font



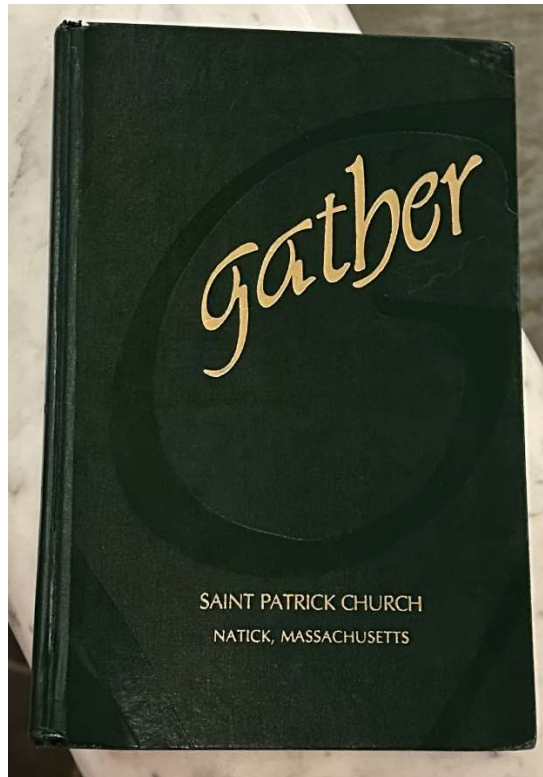
The **Baptismal Font** holds Holy Water used in the Sacrament of Baptism.

St. Patrick Statue



Saint Patrick, our Church's patron saint, helped the people of Ireland to know and love Jesus.

Hymnal



The **hymnal** contains the songs we sing during Mass.

Crucifix



The **Crucifix** reminds us of the sacrifice of Jesus on the altar of the cross.

Ambo



The **Ambo** is the raised platform from which the Word of God is proclaimed.

Sanctus Bells



Listen for the sound of the **Sanctus Bells** during the Consecration, when the bread and wine become Jesus' Body and Blood.

Tabernacle Candle



The light burning in the **Tabernacle Candle** lets us know that the Body of Christ is inside the nearby Tabernacle.

Roman Missal



The **Roman Missal** is the book containing the prayers, chants, and instructions for the celebration of the Mass in the Roman Catholic Church. You can see the priest reading from it on the altar during Mass.

Thurible



The incense burned in the **thurible** represents the prayers of the faithful offered during the sacrifice of the Mass rising up to Heaven.

Ciborium



The **Ciborium** holds the Body of Christ in the Eucharist

Chalice



The **Chalice** holds the Blood of Christ.

Cruets



The cruets hold the water and wine used in the Holy Eucharist.

Chalice Veil



The **Chalice Veil** is used to cover the chalice to protect the Holy Eucharist.

St. Therese Statue



St. Therese of Lisieux reminded us that that God loves us and wants us to trust Him, like little children trust their parents.

Stained Glass Windows



The Stained Glass Windows tell the stories of Jesus and the saints through pictures instead of words.
