SPOTLIGHT AT ST. PATRICK CEMETERY:

1-Shrubs

*Several of the new shrubs that were planted along Lake View in 2024 did not make it through the winter. We received advice from several landscapers and the nursery and replaced those shrubs with Holly.

2- Resurfacing Roads.

*Several roads inside the cemetery were in disrepair. This allowed for difficult snow removal and dangerous icy winter conditions. Fr. Hines addressed the problem and went forward with a major resurfacing project to several of the most used roadways in the cemetery. This is the first phase of a multiyear campaign to make the cemetery roads safe and beatify this sacred place.

3- Cemetery Garage

*The Cemetery Garage on the corner of Pond Street and Lake View Road was showing signs of disrepair and was becoming an eye sore. In conjunction with our Cemetery management company: Mill City Management, rotting wood was replaced and the building was repainted.

4-Cemetery Main Entrance

*The St. Patrick Cemetery Main Entrance, after many years of neglect, continues to be a focus for improvement. The gardens have been mulched, rose bushes were planted, perennials and annuals added, for constant color maintained for a beautiful and welcoming entrance all summer long.
