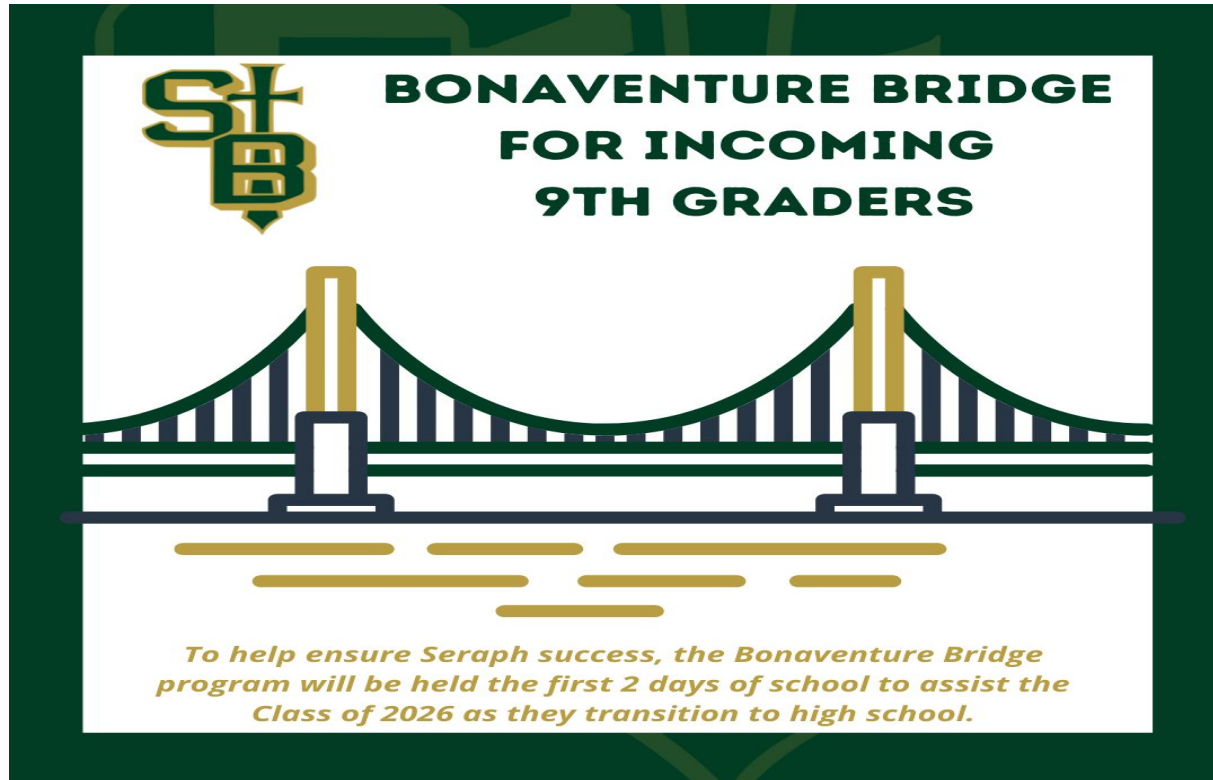


Counseling
