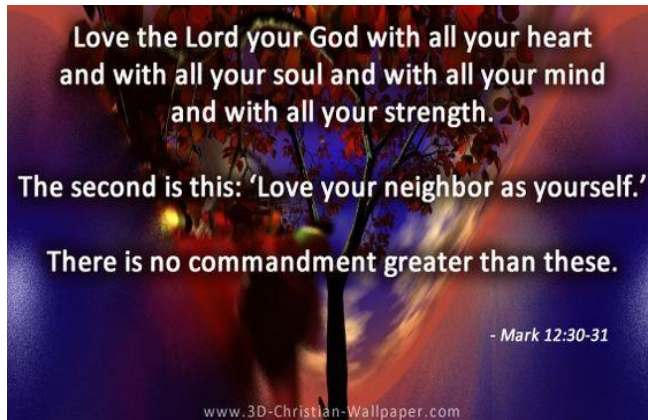

Policies and Procedures



Together, as a community of believers in Christ crucified and resurrected, we will “train up a child in the way he should go, and when he is old he will not depart from it” (Proverbs 22:6). One who believes in and follows Christ is a Christian. A Christian is, first and foremost, called to holiness in Jesus. Our response to that call is to walk in a life of love and service to God and man in God’s earthly kingdom in this life so as to live with God forever in the eternal Kingdom of Heaven in the next. Our hearts are restless in this life until they rest in the living God. We desire to prepare the hearts of God’s children so that they may encounter Him, love Him, trust Him, serve Him, and rest in Him.

The doors of the school will be locked after prayer and will reopen at 12 Noon. It is vital that anyone who will be picking up a student other than the legal guardian be listed on the emergency form.
