In Luke's Gospel, Simeon while near death, anxiously awaits his chance to meet the Christ Child in the presentation of the Lord in the Temple. He amazes Mary and Joseph in the temple, with his enthusiasm and words proclaiming Jesus as the salvation of Israel. He holds Jesus in his arms and gives thanks to God that he has seen His salvation. Simeon, the prophet and Anna, the prophetess, provide a voice to the shepherds visiting the manger in humble homage. Jesus's arrival is herald as the savior who calls men and women for God's Kingdom more than two thousand years ago and today. Learn, Act, Connect and Pray-Mary and Joseph were rich in love for each other and their son, Jesus, bur poor in material goods.
