## 11th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME JUNE 18, 2023

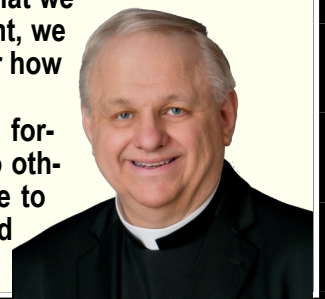
In today's Gospel (Matthew 9:36-10:8), we encounter Jesus as the compassionate shepherd who sees the crowds and is moved with pity for them. He recognizes their struggles, their burdens, and their need for guidance. Jesus describes them as "sheep without a shepherd," highlighting their vulnerability and the longing for someone to lead them.

As we reflect on this passage, we are reminded of the abundant mercy of God. Despite our flaws, failures, and sins, God looks upon us with compassion and understanding. He recognizes our struggles and reaches out to us with an open heart, ready to guide, heal, and forgive. This understanding of God's mercy should fill us with hope and motivate us to seek reconciliation and forgiveness in our own lives.

Jesus goes on to call His disciples and sends them out to continue His mission of compassion and healing. This calling is extended to each one of us as well. We are called to imitate Christ, to be compassionate and merciful towards others, and to share the good news of God's love and forgiveness with those around us.

However, we must also recognize that we too are in need of healing and forgiveness. Just as Jesus extends His mercy to others, He extends it to us as well. It is through the sacrament of Reconciliation that we can experience the transformative power of God's forgiveness in our lives. In this sacrament, we encounter the loving embrace of the Father, who welcomes us back into His arms, no matter how far we may have strayed.

On this 11th Sunday of Ordinary Time, let us reflect on the depth of God's mercy and forgiveness. Let us seek His healing in our own lives and strive to extend that same mercy to others. May we be instruments of God's love, offering compassion, forgiveness, and guidance to those who are lost or in need. May we never forget that we are all sheep in need of our Good Shepherd's loving care. Change is a fundamental part of human existence.



## Through the intercessions of St. Titus Brandsma, pray for us.

Roy and Cynthia recently arrived back from their trip to Boca Raton, where they had the opportunity to meet Father Driscoll. Roy, who had been diagnosed with cancer two years ago, unfortunately experienced a recurrence despite a period of remission. Seeking a miracle, they turned to the intercessions of Saint Brandsma, a figure deeply revered in Roy's native Netherlands.

During their encounter with Father Driscoll, he offered a healing prayer for Roy's well-being while gently placing Titus Brandsma's relic against his head. The experience left an indelible mark on Roy, who described it as truly unforgettable. Throughout their stay with Father Driscoll, they actively participated in Mass, sought the assistance of Our Mother through the Holy Rosary, and engaged in several meetings with Father Driscoll to discuss their situation. To shed light on the significance of Saint Brandsma, a brief overview of his background from the Netherlands, Roy's homeland, is provided below.

### Father Driscoll experienced a healing Miracle attributed to Saint Titus Brandsma

A Florida priest, Father Michael Driscoll, believes that more people should be aware of Saint Titus Brandsma, a Dutch priest, and his brave sacrifice in a Nazi concentration camp. Father Driscoll recounts the boldness of Brandsma, who fearlessly preached his sermons, fully aware that his words were being recorded for Nazi scrutiny.

Father Driscoll has had his share of battles. In 2004, he was diagnosed with advanced melanoma. Around the same time, he received a fragment of Brandsma's black suit which he applied to his head daily. He had a significant surgery where doctors excised 84 lymph nodes and a salivary gland, followed by 35 days of rigorous radiation treatment, as reported by the Boca Raton Sun-Sentinel.

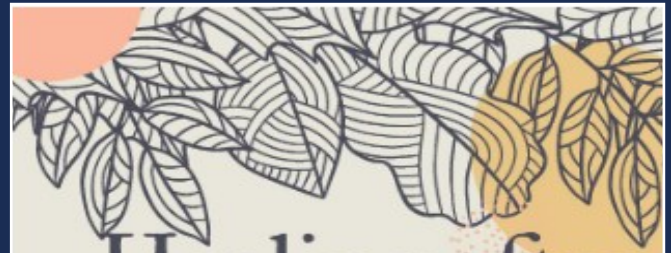
Despite these efforts, his prognosis remained grim, with a mere 10 to 15 percent chance of survival after a decade. Yet, astonishingly, Fr. Driscoll's cancer has completely vanished. The Diocese of Palm Beach announced that doctors acknowledge Fr. Driscoll's recovery from Stage 4 cancer is inexplicable from a medical viewpoint, considering his robust health over the last 20 years.

Three and a half years ago, his doctor told him, "no need to come back, don't waste your money on airfare in coming back here. You're cured. I don't find any more cancer in you." Saint Titus Brandsma beatified by in November 1985 a martyr of the faith and canonized as a saint on 15 May 2022 by Saint Pope John Paul II.

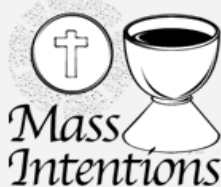
