

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

I find profound significance in the timing of certain liturgical and cultural events as we approach Lent. Notably, the synchrony between Groundhog Day and the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord,

both celebrated on February 2nd, holds particular interest.

This is not merely a coincidence but is rooted in ancient traditions and the rhythms of the natural world. Groundhog Day, a popular cultural observance in North America, is linked to an old European tradition known as Candlemas. Candlemas, which is the Christian Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, commemorates the presentation of Jesus at the Temple. Traditionally, it marks the 40th day after Christmas and is a significant milestone in the Christian calendar.

The link between Groundhog Day and Candlemas stems from old weather lore. Candlemas was a day when candles were blessed, symbolizing Jesus as the light of the world. This day also held traditional beliefs regarding weather patterns. There's an old European saying: "If Candlemas be fair and bright, Come, Winter, have another flight; If Candlemas brings clouds and rain, Go Winter, and come not again." This saying reflects the belief that the weather on Candlemas day could predict the arrival of spring.

Groundhog Day has its roots in this lore. The tradition holds that if a groundhog emerging from its burrow on this day sees its shadow due to clear weather, it will retreat back into its den, and the winter will persist for six more weeks. If it doesn't see its shadow because of cloudiness, spring will arrive early. Hence, Groundhog Day is a secular manifestation of an older tradition that aligns with the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord.

This confluence of a cultural and a religious observance serves as a poignant reminder of the interplay between our faith and the natural world. As we observe the Presentation of the Lord, we are also subtly reminded of the changing seasons and the progression of time, which is beautifully symbolized by the Groundhog Day tradition.

Therefore, take time to rest and prepare for Lent, these observances the religious significance of the Presentation of the Lord and the cultural charm of Groundhog Day - offer a unique perspective. They remind us of our connection to both our faith and the natural world. As we move through February and into Lent, these celebrations serve as a reminder of renewal, both spiritual and seasonal. They encourage us to reset and prepare, not just for the journey to Calvary with Jesus, but also for the transition from the introspection of winter to the hope and renewal of spring.





Are you being called to be a Permanent Deacon?

The Diocese of Belleville is hosting an informational meeting for men and their spouses interested in becoming Permanent Deacons. This meeting will take place on Saturday, February 3, 2024, at 10:00 AM in the Undercroft of the Cathedral of St. Peter, 200 W. Harrison Street, Belleville, IL 62220.

The Office of Permanent Deacon is considering starting a new class of aspirants in fall 2025. Eligibility is extended to men aged thirty-three to fifty-six by September 2025. Men older than fifty-six may still apply but require special approval from the Deacon Formation Office and the Bishop.

The formation process is a five-year commitment, including academic studies conducted by St. Meinrad School of Theology, spiritual direction, and learning about the deacon's role. Participants are required to attend a three-day meeting once per month over the course of the five year program. Interested individuals should first discuss their interest with their pastor. For those unable to attend the initial meeting, another session will be scheduled later. This meeting is an opportunity to learn about the process and requirements for becoming a Permanent Deacon in the Diocese.


