ROSARY

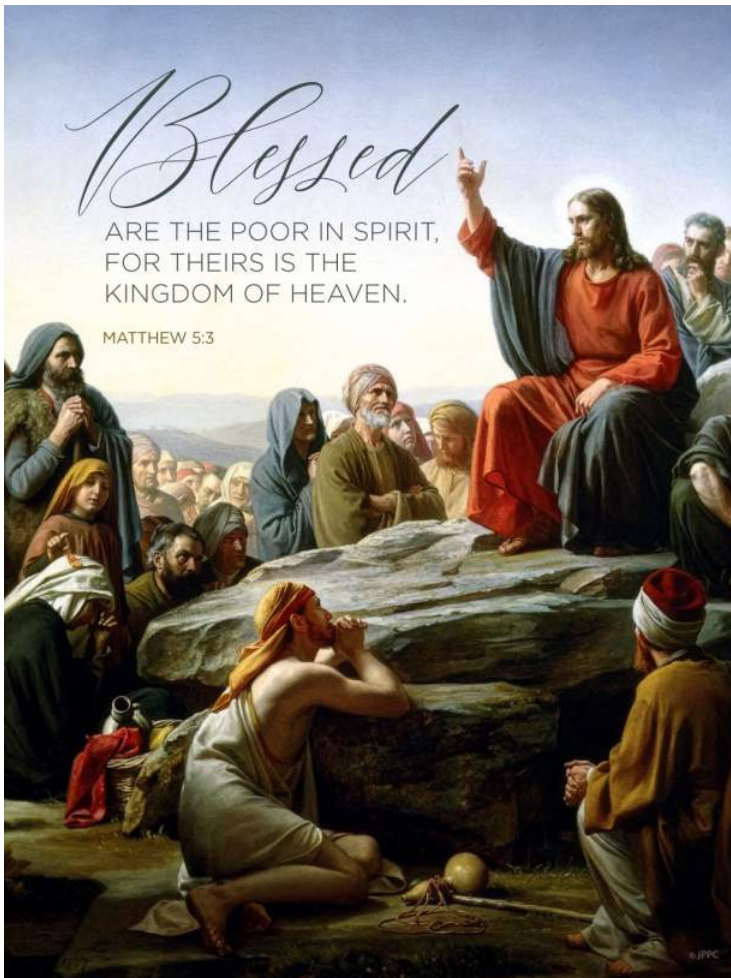
All are invited to gather in prayer Monday through Saturday at 07:30 am as we pray the Rosary together in the church, leading into the 8:00 am Mass.

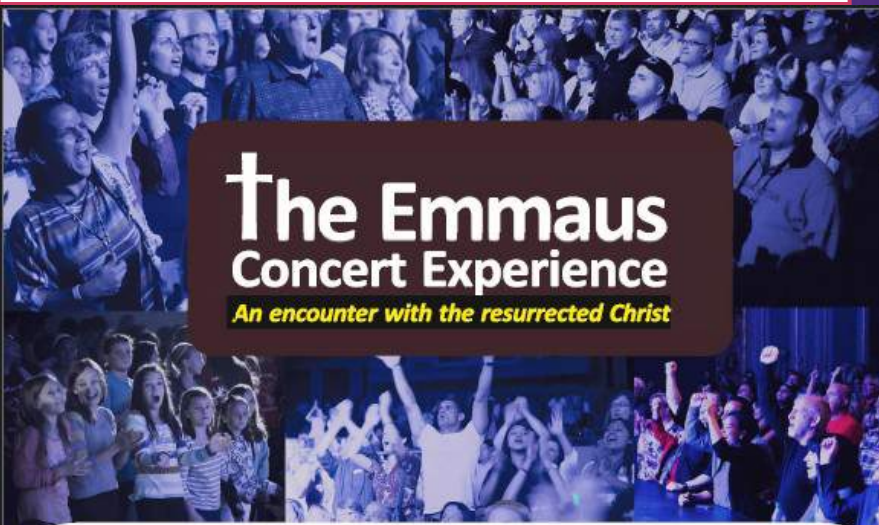
