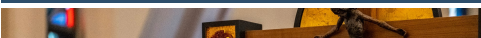

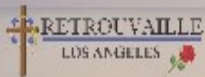

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PRACTICING CATHOLIC

The Best Kind of Mystery

“Do you have a mystery for me to solve?”

If I’ve heard it once, I’ve heard it a hundred times. My daughter is obsessed with mysteries. It’s not enough for her to read about them in the pages of every Nancy Drew book she can get her hands on. She wants more than that. She wants a real-life mystery. A puzzle that resists being solved. A question that eludes an answer. Something that isn’t easy to wrap her head around.

And not surprisingly, she’s not satisfied with the “mysteries” I can offer her. The Mystery of Mom’s Missing Hair Tie (spoiler alert: it was in my purse). The Mystery of the Missing Lunch Ham (oops, Mom finished it).

Simple answers are so boring. “Will I ever have a real mystery?” she moans.

I get it. We’re all this way, really. We are drawn to the mysterious, to the inscrutable. It’s because we *know* that the answers to the really big questions are ones that can’t be explained in a neat and tidy way. We know that the reality of life and love and the human condition is something we can’t quite fit our heads around. We know that there is so much in this world, in this universe, that we can’t...*understand*. So, in a way, mysteries are the only things that really make sense to us.

Why do we love mysteries so much? Because God is a mystery. And that’s never as clear as it is today, on the Feast of the Most Holy Trinity, the mystery that boondoggles us all. Four relations. Three persons. One God.

Don’t ask me to explain it. I could, but I don’t have the word space, and frankly, it might not even make sense then. It’s a mystery, you see. A real one. The best kind.

2nd Reading Question:

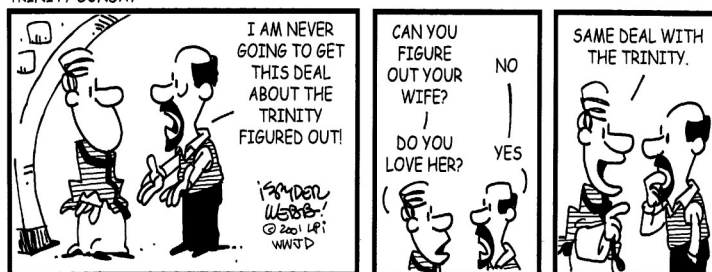

The diocese of Tiruchi is located in the Southern part of India. The Diocese of Tiruchi is blessed with 118 priests serving in 73 parishes with 282 mission stations. It is multi religious in nature, clustered with major religions such as Hinds, Muslims, Buddists & Jains. The total no of Catholics is around 2,77,628 in the diocese. The main source of income is agriculture and daily labor.

SHARING TWO THINGS:

Primarily: Dire need of Mission chapels and
Secondly: Educational Assistance to seminarians and Boys, Girls; Rehab, Post covid.

PROTECTING GOD’S CHILDREN KEEPING KIDS SAFE



DID YOU KNOW? Body safety information for young children

Children should know the difference between “okay” and “not okay” or “good” and “bad” touches – touches that are welcome and comforting, and those that are intrusive, unwanted, painful, or uncomfortable. Children should know that they have the right to say “no” to being touched, even to adults, and that no children or adults should touch their private parts unless in very specific circumstances, and for a healthy purpose. This is where it can be helpful to discuss “safe adults,” like doctors, who check our bodies to help keep us healthy, and only in the presence of a parent or trusted adult. 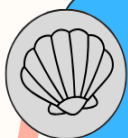

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CATOLICO PRACTICANTE *El Mejor Tipo de Misterio*

“¿Tienes un misterio para mí que resolver?”

Sí, lo he escuchado una vez, lo he escuchado cien veces. Mi hija está obsesionada con los misterios. No le basta con leer sobre ellos en las páginas de todos los libros de Nancy Drew que puede conseguir. Ella quiere más que eso. Quiere un misterio de la vida real. Un rompecabezas que se resiste a ser resuelto. Una pregunta que elude una respuesta. Algo que no es fácil de comprender.

No me sorprende que ella no esté satisfecha con los “misterios” que puedo ofrecerle. El misterio del lazo para el cabello perdido de mamá (spoiler: estaba en mi bolso). El misterio del jamón del almuerzo perdido (ups, mamá lo terminó).

Las respuestas simples son muy aburridas. “¿Tendré alguna vez un verdadero misterio?” se queja ella.

Lo entiendo. Todos somos así en realidad. Nos sentimos atraídos por lo misterioso, por lo inescrutable. Es porque *sabemos* que las respuestas a las preguntas realmente importantes son aquellas que no se pueden explicar de forma clara y ordenada.

Sabemos que la realidad de la vida, el amor y la condición humana es algo que no podemos comprender. Sabemos que hay tantas cosas en este mundo, en este universo, que no podemos... *comprender*. Entonces, de cierto modo, los misterios son las únicas cosas que, en realidad, tienen sentido para nosotros.

¿Por qué amamos tanto los misterios? Porque Dios es un misterio. Eso nunca ha sido tan claro como lo es ahora, en la Fiesta de la Santísima Trinidad, el misterio que nos desconcierta a todos. Cuatro relaciones. Tres personas. Un Dios.

No me pidas que te lo explique. Podría, pero no tengo el espacio para explicarlo, y, francamente, puede que ni siquiera tenga sentido entonces. Es un misterio, lo ves. Uno de verdad. El mejor de su tipo.

La diócesis de Tiruchi se encuentra en el sur de la India. Cuenta con 118 sacerdotes que sirven en 73 parroquias y 282 estaciones misioneras. Es multirreligiosa, con presencia de las principales religiones como hindúes, musulmanes, budistas y jainistas. El número total de católicos en la diócesis es de aproximadamente 277.628. La principal fuente de ingresos es la agricultura y el trabajo diario.

Principalmente: Urgente necesidad de capillas para la Misión.

En segundo lugar: Asistencia educativa para seminaristas, niños y niñas; rehabilitación post-COVID.

Puede ser útil hablar de “adultos de confianza”, como los doctores que revisan nuestros cuerpos para ayudar a mantenernos sanos, y sólo en presencia de un padre o un adulto de confianza. 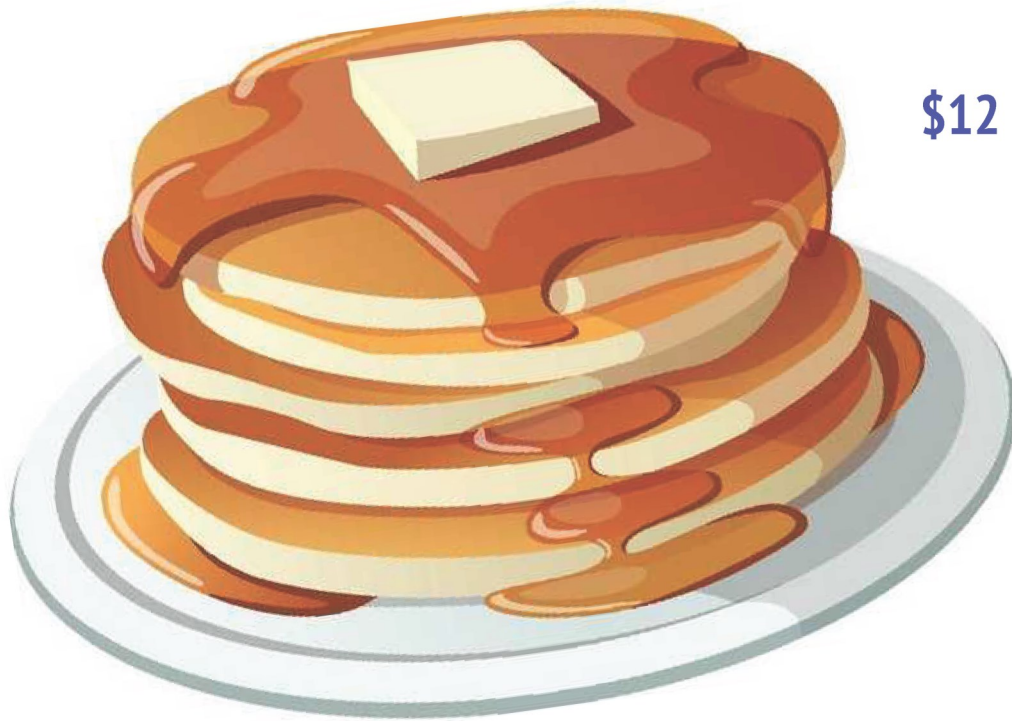
