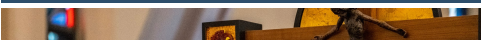

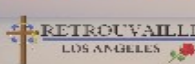

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PRACTICING CATHOLIC

As the Day Was drawing to a Close

It isn’t uncommon for me to get to the noon hour only to realize that I haven’t yet eaten anything that day.

It drives my husband crazy. He was raised by a bunch of Italian women, so he can’t help but think three meals ahead. And don’t get me wrong, I love food — I literally dream of donuts. But some days, I’m just so busy and I keep putting it off until I realize how weak I feel, how light-headed. And I think to myself: *Stupid, you’ve done it again.*

This is what comes to mind today, on the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, as I read the Gospel account of the miracle of the loaves and fishes.

I think of hunger, distraction and the poor planning of those who pride themselves on being capable.

“As the day was drawing to a close,” it is written — that’s when the disciples finally realized that 5,000 hungry people is not an ideal situation.

I wonder, did Jesus roll his eyes when they came to him, and think, “Finally”? At any point he could have pulled out a fish and said a blessing. But he waited for them to ask. He waited for them to realize how badly they needed it.

Sometimes we forget that we *need* the Eucharist. It’s not just a nice thing to have, a sweet act of devotion, a sacramental item that bolsters our faith. The Eucharist is none of those things. The Eucharist is the food without which we will die. The Eucharist is something we must seek out. Remember: the day is drawing to a close.

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LIVE THE LITURGY

Inspiration for the week

Five loaves and two fish: a measly portion of food for such a large crowd of people. But we must remember that it doesn’t matter what the size of our offering is. If we only lay it before Christ, he will take it and make it a mighty bounty.

2nd Reading Question:

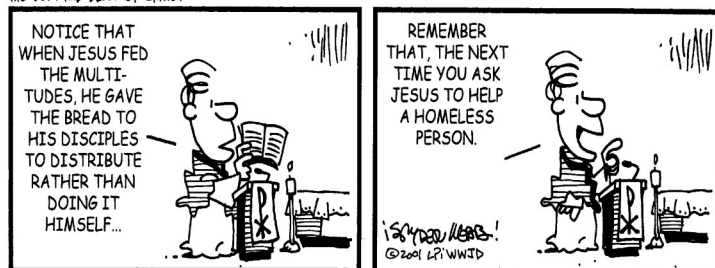

A medida que el día llegaba a su fin

No es raro que llegue al medio día y me dé cuenta que aún no he comido nada ese día.

A mi esposo lo vuelve loco. Fue criado por un grupo de mujeres italianas, por lo que no puede evitar pensar en tres comidas por adelantado. No me malinterpretes, amo la comida y literalmente sueño con las donas. Sin embargo, algunos días estoy tan ocupada que lo sigo posponiendo hasta que me doy cuenta de lo débil y aturdida que me siento. Pienso para mí misma: *tonta, lo has vuelto a hacer.*

Esto es lo que me viene a la mente hoy, en la Solemnidad del Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo, mientras leo el relato del Evangelio del milagro de la multiplicación de los panes y los peces.

Pienso en el hambre, la distracción y la mala planificación de quienes se enorgullecen de ser capaces.

“A medida que el día llegaba a su fin”, está escrito, fue cuando los discípulos finalmente se dieron cuenta que 5,000 personas hambrientas no es una situación ideal.

Me pregunto si Jesús puso los ojos en blanco cuando vinieron por él y pensó: “¡Por fin!” En cualquier momento, él podría haber sacado un pez y dicho una bendición. Sin embargo, él esperó a que le preguntaran. Esperó a que se dieran cuenta de lo mucho que lo necesitaban.

A veces olvidamos que *necesitamos* la Eucaristía. Esta no es solo algo agradable de tener, un acto dulce de devoción, un elemento sacramental que refuerza nuestra fe. La Eucaristía no es ninguna de esas cosas. La Eucaristía es el alimento sin el cual moriremos. La Eucaristía es algo que debemos buscar. Recuerda: el día está llegando a su fin.
