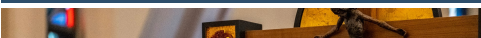

Some Say

At first, the Apostles try to dodge the question.

When Jesus confronts them — and make no mistake, it is a confrontation — with the question “Who do you say that I am?” they act like a man whose wife has just asked him if she looks fat in these jeans.

The evasiveness of their answer puts politicians to shame: “Some say John the Baptist, others Elijah, still others Jeremiah or one of the prophets.”

Some say.

But Jesus doesn’t let them off easy. He repeats himself. He wants an answer. “Who do you say that I am?”

They all know the answer. They all believe the answer. And they all know the answer could get them thrown in prison or killed. Only Peter is brave enough to say it: “You are the Christ, the Son of the Living God.”

People have a lot of opinions about God. They always have. They have a lot of opinions about Jesus and the Bible, about the Catholic Church and the Pope. Some of these opinions are well-founded, well-researched. Some of them are based in ignorance. Many are born of painful misunderstandings. But they are all just that: opinions.

Some say.

We know who Jesus is. We know who the Eucharist is. We know what the truth is. Amid the chaos and the violence and the excruciating *loudness* of this fallen world and all the words it shouts into the void about God and Jesus and right and wrong, *we know*.

But will we answer?

DID YOU KNOW? Summer and water safety at home

While parents are often hyper vigilant around pools and lakes, drowning can happen at home in an instant, especially with very young children. This summer, watch children around water at home, including buckets, containers, and kiddie pools. Children can drown in as little as an inch of water, so constant supervision is necessary. A Moment of Transition

The Office of the Vicar of Clergy has informed me that Fr. Jorge’s term of service to St. Frances of Rome will come to an end on June 30. This will complete Fr. Jorge’s year of service to our parish. On July 1, Fr. Jorge will begin his next assignment at the parish of Mary Immaculate in Pacoima within the San Fernando Valley. His reassignment allows him to continue his journey and process leading to his incardination within the Archdiocese of Los Angeles. We wish him well on his continued journey of becoming a priest within the archdiocese and thank him for his faithful service to our parish.

The Office of the Vicar of Clergy has also informed me that Archbishop Gomez has assigned Fr. Kamil Ziolkowski as our next parochial vicar. Fr. Kamil was ordained a priest of the Archdiocese of Los Angeles in 2022. Fr.’s first assignment was at St. Joseph’s in Hawthorne in the South Bay area. Fr. Kamil is a native of Poland. His studies for the priesthood began in Chicago. Fr. would later transfer to Los Angeles and complete his studies to the priesthood at St. John’s Seminary in Camarillo. Fr. is conversant in Polish, German, Spanish and English.

Fr. Kamil has been assigned to St. Frances of Rome for a period of three years. He also begins his service to our parish on July 1. We welcome him to our parish community.

Todos saben la respuesta. Todos creen conocer la respuesta. Todos saben que la respuesta podría hacer que los encarcelen o los maten. Solo Pedro tiene el valor de decirlo: “Tú eres Cristo, el Hijo del Dios Vivo”.

Algunas de estas opiniones están bien fundamentadas e investigadas. Algunas de ellas se basan en la ignorancia. Muchas se originan de malentendidos dolorosos. Pero todas son solo eso: opiniones.

Algunos dicen.

Todos sabemos quién es Jesús. Todos sabemos quién es la Eucaristía. Todos sabemos cuál es la verdad. En medio del caos, la violencia y el *ruido* insoportable de este mundo caído y todas las palabras que gritan al vacío sobre Dios y Jesús, el bien y el mal, *nosotros sabemos*.

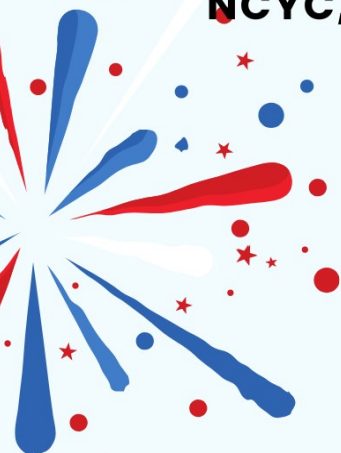
