Thank you for being such an important part of our St. Michael Catholic School community. We can't wait to celebrate together!

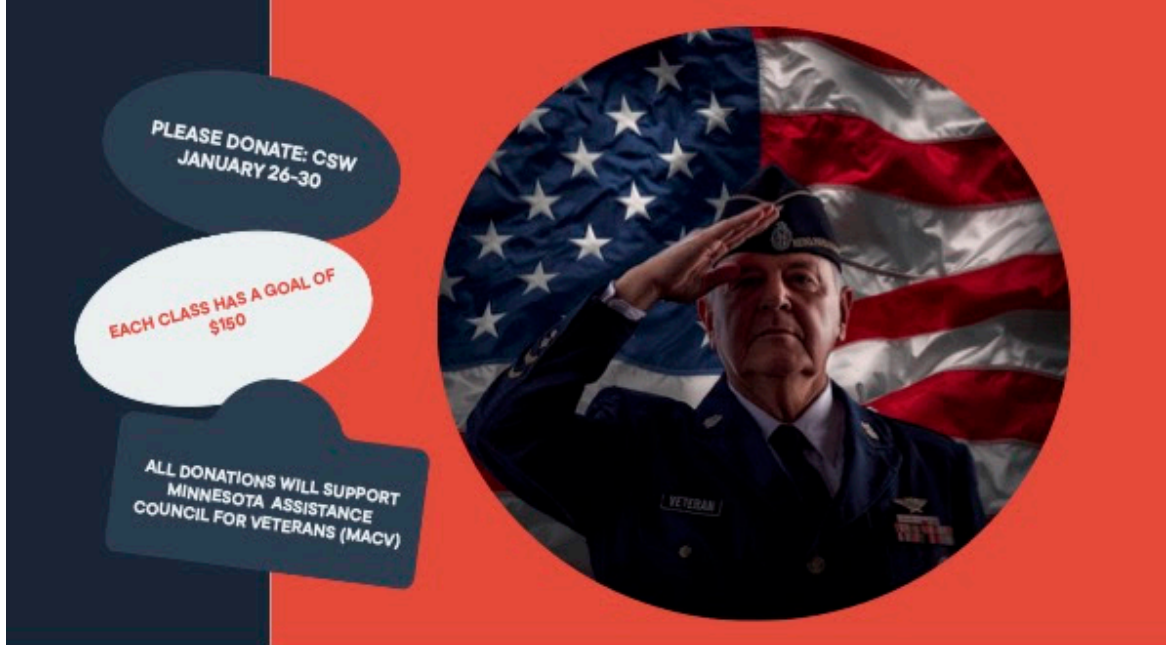

### Dress Code Update From Mr. Sartori

I am writing to inform recent questions regarding Ugg footwear. We understand that Uggs are a popular and comfortable choice, especially during colder months. However, most Ugg styles do not meet the St. Michael Catholic School dress code requirements.

Our dress code states: "Shoes must be worn at all times and must have a **closed toe and heel.**" While some Uggs include a partial heel, many styles do not have a full back that comes up high enough to be considered a closed heel. For this reason, most slipper-style or slide-in Uggs are not permitted.

Ugg styles that include a full back (such as boot styles with a complete heel and cuff) are acceptable. If you are unsure whether a specific style meets the dress code, please feel free to reach out for clarification.
